partly due to the difficulties of reading and interpreting poetic texts the lack of criticism on asian american poetry speaks to the urgent need for scholarship in this area since perhaps more than any other genre poetry most forcefully captures the intense feelings and emotions that asian americans have experienced about themselves and their world this reference book overviews the tremendous cultural contributions of asian american poets included are alphabetically arranged entries on 48 american poets of asian descent most of whom have been active during the latter half of the 20th century each entry begins with a short biography which sometimes includes information drawn from personal interviews the entries then discuss the poet s major works and themes including such concerns as family racism sexism identity language and politics a survey of the poet s critical reception follows in many cases the existing criticism is scant and the entries offer new readings of neglected works the entries conclude with bibliographies of primary and secondary texts and the volume closes with a selected general bibliography

this book examines the influence of genre on contemporary asian american literary production drawing on cultural theories of representation social theories of identity and poststructuralist genre theory this study shows how popular prose fictions have severely constrained the development of asian american literary aesthetics

empire and environment argues that histories of imperialism colonialism militarism and global capitalism are integral to understanding environmental violence in the transpacific region the collection draws its rationale from the imbrication of imperialism and global environmental crisis but its inspiration from the ecological work of activists artists and intellectuals across the transpacific region taking a postcolonial ecocritical approach to confronting ecological ruin in an age of ecological crises and environmental catastrophes on a global scale the collection demonstrates how asian north american asian diasporic and indigenous pacific island cultural expressions critique a de historicized sense of place attachment and belonging in addition to its thirteen chapters from scholars who span the pacific each part of this volume begins with a poem by craig santos perez the volume also features a foreword by macarena gobarri and an afterword by priscilla wald
