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the prayer and tears of jacques derrida takes its point of departure from derrida s more recent sometimes autobiographical writings and closely examines the religious motifs that have emerged in his later works john d caputo s provocative interpretation of derrida s thinking also makes an original contribution to the question of the relevance of deconstruction for religion caputo s derrida is a man of faith who bridges jewish and christian traditions the deep messianic apocalyptic and prophetic tones in derrida s writings caputo argues bespeak his broken covenant with judaism through its startling exploration of derrida s impossible religion the book sheds light on the implications of deconstruction for an understanding of religion and faith today from back cover

reading dante s commedia alongside jacques derrida s later religious writings francis j ambrosio explores what these works reveal about religion as a fundamental dynamic of human existence about freedom and responsibility and about the significance of writing itself ambrosio argues that both the many telling differences between them and the powerful bonds that unite them across centuries show that dante and derrida share an identity as religious writers that arises from the human experiences of faith hope and love in response to the divine mystery of being human for both dante and derrida ambrosio contends scriptural religion reveals that the paradoxical tension of freedom and absolute responsibility must lead to the mystery of forgiveness a secret that these two share and faithfully keep by surrendering to its necessity to die so as always to begin again anew

a rhetoric and philosophy of gifts synthesizes a scope of rhetorical and philosophical perspectives of the gift eberhardinger asks what is the relationship between gifts and rhetoric she contextualizes the question throughout a review of related literature analysis examples and personal anecdotes of overseas experiences eberhardinger concludes the book by offering implications and opportunities for interpreting gifts thereby addressing why the question concerning the relationship between gifts and rhetoric matters for the larger landscape of international relations intercultural friendship and peace making scholars of communication rhetoric and philosophy will find this book particularly interesting

emmanuel levinas 1905 1995 was one of the foremost thinkers of the twentieth century his work influencing a wide range of intellectuals

such as maurice blanchot jacques derrida luce irigaray and jean luc marion
