that the teachings presented in this book were the orthodox consensus of the early church for the first 300 years and that it was augustine who introduced serious deviations into the mainstream orthodox christianity of his time forster and marston begin by describing the battle that is being waged between god and the spiritual forces that oppose him they examine the book of job and see how this relates to the overall struggle then the authors examine the 9th chapter of romans to see if this book is dealing with election and individual destinies or god s actions within human history the authors do an excellent job of arguing for their opinion that this chapter is speaking about god s involvement in human history and it deals with god s choosing of one nation or individual over another nation or individual to accomplish his purpose other sections of interest in this book are the sections on foreknowledge and predestination and the chapters on faith and works the section on faith and works was particularly interesting because it relies on much of the teaching of the new perspective which has shed much light on how a 1st century palestinian jew would have approached scriptural issues the research argumenation and exegesis in this book are solid so every chapter is excellent but the ones mentioned above were two of my favorites amazon com
