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last word is the popular bbc radio 4 series broadcast weekly featuring the lives of several famous people who have recently died more than standard obituaries the lives are summarised with narration and include interviews with some of those who knew them the programme was first broadcast in 2006 and this compelling anthology commemorates the remarkable and revealing lives of 80

women who were illuminating inspiring or moving their names may not always be well known but their lives made an impact on the world and they broke new ground in many different ways the book includes It islam bibi helmand s top female police officer shot dead by the taliban naty revuelta clews fidel castro s mistress naomi sims first black supermodel sylvia robinson the mother of hip hop who was the founder ceo of sugar hill records rosalia mera zara founder the world s richest self made woman marie colvin celebrated war reporter killed in homs clare hollingworth first war correspondent to report the outbreak of the second world war eileen nearne wartime spy who was captured and tortured by the gestapo salome karwah ebola survivor who went back to liberia to nurse other sufferers jo cox mp murdered in her own yorkshire constituency jill saward rape survivor and campaigner for victims of sexual abuse scharlette holdman the angel of death row who fought against the death penalty in the us jeanne cordova former nun who became a lesbian rights activist francis kelsey pharmacologist who prevented the licence of thalidomide in the us margaret rule archaeologist who raised the mary rose countess of arran powerboat racer the fastest granny on water

based on years of fieldwork in both rural and urban greece the last word explores women s cultural resistance as they weave together diverse social practices improvised antiphonic laments divinatory dreaming the care and tending of olive trees and the dead and the inscription of emotions and the senses on a landscape of persons things and places these practices compose the empowering poetics of the cultural periphery c nadia seremetakis liberates the analysis of gender from reductive binary models and pioneers the alternative perspective of self reflexive native anthropology in european ethnography

attempting to avert malpractice for voluntary intervention outside of the realm of a psychiatrist a patient is diagnosed as a paranoid schizophrenic conveniently within the realm of psychiatry leading to the decision to take a medical discharge from the shared employer rather than agree to take psychotic medication with all the associated and numerous potential side effects while seeking commensurate compensation for a host of injustices including wrongful release malpractice inclusive of experimentation wilful negligence and even fraud and attempted blackmail not only do the relevant systems fail but without exception so do the respective appeal levels resulting in our subject ending up in jail temporarily in solitary confinement now alleged of becoming a dangerous paranoid schizophrenic forced to forfeit all firearms as well as subsequently agree to an order ordinance prohibiting the possession of any firearms or ammunitions for a period of five years effectively for live rendering canada a democratically elected government regulated by nothing more than dictators that the appointed courts condone once mortgage free with sizable savings and numerous other assets the victim over a decade later after meeting with about 50 lawyers is broke and mortgaged to the hilt barely able to make minimum monthly payments to remain in a modest 1232 square feet home and afford a life style consisting of little more than the essentials while watching his long held belief of becoming married and having children with someone of his choice in an affluent lifestyle vanish as the sun sets on his youthful years still celibate and no closure to financial compensation for any injustice still experiencing cruelty

the last word argues that the hollywood novel opened up space for cultural critique of the film industry at a time when the industry lacked the capacity to critique itself while the young studio system worked tirelessly to burnish its public image in the wake of celebrity scandal several industry insiders wrote fiction to fill in what newspapers and fan magazines left out throughout the 1920s and 1930s these novels aimed to expose the invisible machinery of classical hollywood cinema including not only the evolving artifice of the screen but also the promotional discourse that complemented it as likeminded filmmakers in the 1940s and 1950s gradually brought the dark side of the industry to the screen however the hollywood novel found itself struggling to live up to its original promise of delivering the unfilmable by the 1960s desperate to remain relevant the genre had devolved into little more than erotic fantasy of movie stars behind closed doors perhaps the only thing the public couldn't already find elsewhere still given their unique ability to speak beyond the institutional restraints of their time these earlier works offer a window into the industry's dynamic creation and re-creation of itself in the public imagination

there have been many studies of the women in the gospels but this is a new kind of book on the subject rather than offering a general overview of the gospel women or focusing on a single theme richard bauckham studies in great depth both the individual women who appear in the gospels and the specific passages in which they appear this unique approach reveals that there is much more to be known about such women than previous studies have assumed employing historical and literary readings of the biblical texts bauckham successfully captures the particularity of each woman he studies an opening look at the old testament book of ruth

introduces the possibilities of reading scripture from a woman's perspective other studies examine the women found in matthew's genealogies the prophet anna mary of clopas joanna salome and the women featured in the gospel resurrection narrative a number of these women have never been the subject of deep theological enquiry unlike most recent books bauckham's work is not dominated by a feminist agenda it does not presume in advance that the gospel texts support patriarchal oppression but it does venture some of the new and surprising possibilities that arise when the texts are read from the perspective of their female characters astute sensitive to issues of gender and written by one of today's leading theologians gospel women will be of interest to a wide range of readers
