category is different from the others and that novels within categories are similar thus it provides a coherent vision of selvon s canon it illustrates as well the development of selvon s philosophy of west indians as peasant bourgeois and immigrant in doing so it explores the significance of ethnicity in his works and discusses selvon s imaginative apotheosis of the indo trinidadian peasant and the diminution of the afro trinidadian immigrant the volume also studies selvon s fictional and rhetorical techniques and argues that his works range from bildungsroman to picaresque to epic to satire
