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providing an excellent example of why folk artists can be appreciated as carriers of knowledge even if they are unaware of it this book could change the ways we understand and appreciate american folk arts connecting a sharecropper from georgia in the southern united states to a protector and healer in touba senegal west africa the holy city of mouridism and the final resting place of its founder shaikh ahmadou bamba mbàcke it makes an interesting link while examining the cultural aspects of two very different and yet similar paths of life historians and art historians alike will find this investigation of african american art and folk culture both interesting and insightful not only does this book trace the characteristics of art through the african diaspora but it also traces islam through those same diasporic transportations of colonial exploration and slavery

our four volumes propose to present innovative thematic applications implemented using the open source software qgis these are applications that use remote sensing over continental surfaces the four volumes detail applications of remote sensing over continental surfaces with a first one discussing applications for agriculture a second one presents applications for forest a third presents applications for the continental hydrology and finally the last volume details applications for environment and risk issues

this book constitutes the refereed proceedings of the second eai international conference on pervasive knowledge and collective intelligence on and social media persom 2023 which took place in hyderabad india during november 24 25 2023 the 28 full papers included in the proceedings were carefully reviewed and selected from 70 submissions they focus on information and mining social network analysis semantic network analysis trust reputation social control and privacy information reliability and and content authenticity

being there and the evolution of a screenplay provides an insightful look at the drafting of one of hollywood history s greatest scripts being there 1979 is generally considered the final film in hal ashby s triumphant 1970s career which included the likes of harold and maude 1971 and shampoo 1975 the film also showcases peter sellers s last great performance in 2005 the writers guild of america included being there on its list of 101 best scripts being there and the evolution of a screenplay

features three versions of the script an early draft by jerzy kosinski based on his 1970 novel a second by long time ashby collaborator and oscar winner robert c jones which makes substantial changes to kosinki s and a final draft written by jones with ashby s assistance which makes further structural and narrative changes additionally the book features facsimile pages from one of kosinski s copy of the scripts that include handwritten notes providing readers with valuable insight into the redrafting process for each version ashby scholar aaron hunter adds perceptive analysis of the script s development the relationships of the writers who worked on it and key studio and production details this is both a presentation of the script of being there and a record of the process of crafting that script a text that will be of interest to film fans and scholars as well as writers and teachers of screenwriting evolution of a screenplay is the first book of its kind to so amply demonstrate the creative development of a hollywood script

this report presents the instruction manual of the new water stress plugin developed by fao in collaboration with the stockholm environment institute s u s center sei for the calculation of the sdg indicator 6 4 2 level of water stress freshwater withdrawal as a proportion of available freshwater resources by river basin since the indicator was introduced in 2015 it has been used widely to estimate the level of water stress experienced at the country or regional level with this new plugin countries will be able to assess sdg 6 4 2 at the basin and sub basin levels providing a different and more hydrologically sound view on the dynamics of water resources and their use the plugin allows exploring the spatial and interannual trends of the level of water stress within a basin avoiding any multiple counting of its freshwater resources and taking into consideration the needs of water supply of the different sections of the basin by supporting the improvement of water monitoring and management this report contributes to the achievement of sdg 6

gis and geocomputation for water resource science and engineering not only provides a comprehensive introduction to the fundamentals of geographic information systems but also demonstrates how gis and mathematical models can be integrated to develop spatial decision support systems to support water resources planning management and engineering the book uses a hands on active learning approach to introduce fundamental concepts and numerous case studies are provided to reinforce learning and demonstrate practical aspects the benefits and challenges of using gis in environmental and water resources fields are clearly tackled in this book demonstrating how these technologies can be used to harness increasingly available digital data to develop spatially oriented sustainable solutions in addition to providing a strong grounding on fundamentals the book also demonstrates how gis can be combined with traditional physics based and statistical models as well as information theoretic tools like neural networks and fuzzy set theory

over 3 000 years ago since then jewish law has developed various interpretations and applications of the torah interpretations of those interpretations and so on jewish law contains civil dictates as well as religious protocol problems that arose in the framework of religious life and problems surrounding civil relationships both found solutions in the same legal source the torah and the halacha the jewish legal interpretations and rulings this chapter on water law in the jewish tradition provides insight into jewish law and custom in general and rules related to the protection of water sources in particular one should not look however to find a written code of jewish law as there is none

in a history of water engineering and management in yemen ingrid hehmeyer describes the three way relationship between water land and humans from ancient to medieval and premodern times as illustrated in case studies from four sites individual ecosystems necessitated different engineering and management approaches in order to make good use of the scarce water resources for both irrigated agriculture and domestic consumption material remains and written sources provide the evidence for a comprehensive examination of continuity and change technical and managerial struggles failures and successes the question of technology transfer the impact of the religion of islam on water use and allocation and people s reactions in times of severe crisis

the sustainable governance of water resources relies on processes of multi stakeholder collaborations and interactions that facilitate knowledge co creation and social learning governance systems are often fragmented forming a barrier to adequately addressing the myriad of challenges affecting water resources including climate change increased urbanized populations and pollution transitions towards sustainable water governance will likely require innovative learning partnerships between public private and civil society stakeholders it is essential that such partnerships involve vertical and horizontal communication of ideas and knowledge and an enabling and democratic environment characterized by informal and open discourse there is increasing interest in learning based transitions thus far much scholarly thinking and to a lesser degree empirical research has gone into understanding the potential impact of social learning on multi stakeholder settings the question of whether such learning can be supported by forms of serious gaming has hardly been asked this special issue critically explores the potential of serious games to support multi stakeholder social learning and collaborations in the context of water governance serious games may involve simulations of real world events and processes and are challenge players to solve contemporary societal problems they therefore have a purpose beyond entertainment they offer a largely untapped potential to support social learning and collaboration by facilitating access to and the exchange of knowledge and information enhancing stakeholder interactions empowering a wider audience to participate in decision making and providing opportunities to test and analyze the outcomes of policies and management solutions

little is known about how game based approaches can be used in the context of collaborative water governance to maximize their potential for social learning while several studies have reported examples of serious games there is comparably less research about how to assess the impacts of serious games on social learning and transformative change
