wilson who is acknowledged for the consistently high quality of his prose whether it be fiction nonfiction or criticism has refused to accept the limitations of genre or form or to be placed in some literary cubbyhole clifford p bendau here covers wilson s work from his first appearance as a literary enfant terrible to the publication of his landmark novel the space vampires 1976 regarded by many critics as one of his finest works
