the babes of former generations were certainly lucky for they possessed quite the best book of nursery rhymes which has ever been published the nursery rhyme book by andrew lang and illustrated by I leslie brooke is a complete collection of the old nursery rhymes which have delighted so many generations adorned with attractive pictures and accompanied by a preface written in one of mr lang s
