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based on her extensive experience in the urban communities of los angeles historian and architect dolores hayden proposes new perspectives on gender race and ethnicity to broaden the practice of public history and public art enlarge urban preservation and reorient the writing of urban history to spatial struggles in the first part of the power of place hayden outlines the elements of a social history of urban space to connect people s lives and livelihoods to the urban landscape as it changes over time she then explores how communities and professionals can tap the power of historic urban landscapes to nurture public memory the second part documents a decade of research and practice by the power of place a nonprofit organization hayden founded in downtown los angeles through public meetings walking tours artists s books and permanent public sculpture as well as architectural preservation teams of historians designers planners and artists worked together to understand preserve and commemorate urban landscape history as african american latina and asian american families have experienced it one project celebrates the urban homestead of biddy mason an african american ex slave and midwife active between 1856 and 1891 another reinterprets the embassy

theater where rose pesotta luisa moreno and josefina fierro de bright organized latina dressmakers and cannery workers in the 1930s and 1940s a third chapter tells the story of a historic district where japanese american family businesses flourished from the 1890s to the 1940s each project deals with bitter memories slavery repatriation internment but shows how citizens survived and persevered to build an urban life for themselves their families and their communities drawing on many similar efforts around the united states from new york to charleston seattle to cincinnati hayden finds a broad new movement across urban preservation public history and public art to accept american diversity at the heart of the vernacular urban landscape she provides dozens of models for creative urban history projects in cities and towns across the country

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how far would you go to save someone you love and what if that someone was not exactly human guy schmerhorn brilliant young professor of psychology and disciple of the pioneering dr moncrieff is making a name for himself on the talk show circuit with an unusual protégé in tow a chimp by the name of sam sam lives in guy's apartment wears diapers and neckties devours pizza and macdonalds and through guy's careful training can communicate through sign language but living with sam is wreaking havoc on guy's personal life and when shy meek undergraduate aimee villard volunteers to take on babysitting for him he can't believe his luck aimee and sam have an immediate rapport and before guy knows it she's moved in proudly devoting herself to sam's care and guy's project aimee has never known purpose and happiness like this but when guy's funding is imperilled and sam is taken away by the sinister moncrieff her world falls apart aimee discovers just how far she'll go to and just what she'll risk to be united with the chimp she's come to love so much

the moving portrait of a woman stranded in her lonely fame franny fuller blond buxom and beguiling is the sort of woman who harnesses a power that can enthrall a nation the legendary movie star has captured the imaginations of audiences men and columnist mary maguire who is writing her biography but just who is the human within the celebrity this is the story of how fanny marker from utica new york was transformed into franny fuller a famous actress with a life of private misery doris grumbach takes readers beyond the glamour of the silver screen with this poignant novel of one woman's sad reality

inviting us to wallow in the middle judith roof offers a fresh inventive look at female comic secondary characters who though never on center stage play an indispensable role in enriching and complicating the course of the narrative paying attention to these characters shows that narrative is not always as straight as it might seem focusing on such superb comic seconds as eve arden thelma ritter rosalind russell and whoopi goldberg roof explores what is queer about the middle in the sense of eccentric and in terms of desire and how that queerness functions as a part of and an antidote to narrative shrewd pragmatic self denying perceptive outspoken and witty these female characters are able to cross the bounds of social groupings gender expectations and propriety presenting possibilities that threaten the fitting ends of narrative closure norms such as heterosexuality production reproduction knowledge and victory roof characterizes female seconds as modern day versions of the shakespearian fool able to speak the truth without being punished for it discussing films ranging from mildred pierce auntie mame and rear window to stage door sister act and the associate she shows how hollywood s recasting of the wise servant figure as female unattached and lower class reflects more general cultural anxieties about the role of women gender confusion race and class distinctions she also tracks changes in the form and function of the minor and middle from the stylized hierarchical economy of classical hollywood film to the expanded serial variety fitted to 1990s commodity culture a meticulous playful rereading of hollywood classics from the margins all about thelma and eve registers both delight in these female characters and discernment of their integral role in unseating narrative and other norms

a chilling secret from the past leads to a violent murder in the present mitchell and markby must put their wedding plans on hold when an old friend seeks their help in that way murder lies the fifteenth english village murder mystery in ann granger s mitchell markby series the perfect read for fans of kathy cranston agatha christie and itv s midsomer murders when meredith mitchell s old friend toby smythe turns up on leave she is delighted to see him but toby has a problem or rather his relative alison jenner has and he wants to enlist the help of meredith s fiance detective superintendent alan markby alison has been receiving anonymous hate mail which alludes to the murder of her aunt freda kemp of which alison was acquitted when she was just twenty who is the writer and how does he or she know about this secret in alison s past markby is at first reluctant to become involved especially as he and meredith are busy planning their wedding but enquiries into a poison pen campaign soon turn into a murder hunt with the help of inspector jessica campbell a new member of markby s team the investigation unravels a twenty five year old mystery and its dreadful legacy of violence what readers are saying about that way murder lies enjoyable clever incredibly entertaining and interesting book anyone who enjoys a delightful english cosy that is a clever blending of amateur sleuth and police procedural will enjoy this series quite a mystery right up to the very end

in the 1970s manhattan s west side waterfront was a forgotten zone of abandoned warehouses and piers though many saw only blight the derelict neighborhood was alive with queer people forging new intimacies through cruising alongside the piers sexual and social worlds artists produced work attesting to the radical transformations taking place in new york artist and writer david wojnarowicz was right in the heart of it documenting his experiences in journal entries poems photographs films and large scale site specific projects in cruising the dead river fiona anderson draws on wojnarowicz s work to explore the key role the abandoned landscape played in this explosion of queer culture anderson

examines how the riverfront's ruined buildings assumed a powerful erotic role and gave the area a distinct identity by telling the story of the piers as gentrification swept New York and before the AIDS crisis Anderson unearths the buried histories of violence, regeneration and LGBTQ activism that developed in and around the cruising scene

first published in the year 1928 the present novel *The Pirate Woman* is a fictional romantic adventure novel by one of the most acclaimed writers Aylward Edward Dingle this novel is an unique one of its kind fiction which depicts a ferocious pirate woman as the main character of it

in 1880 West Texas Dave Smith seeks a way to stay alive after choosing to run away from a family scandal in St. Louis Dave encounters Drunken Red Talbot and learns a hard knock lesson in a one-sided fistfight Pinto Larson, Willy owner of the checker board ranch, believes Dave Smith can become a seasoned drover with training from Sam Eagle Feather, the Cheyenne Indian adopted by Pinto while the two are at a remote line camp they rescue a battered woman Sam acknowledges he has feelings for the woman and takes her to safety ignoring laws relating to Indians trouble develops for both of them when crazed Red Talbot calls out Sam in a fatal fight in which Dave makes a deadly decision through a series of lethal encounters Dave becomes a gun hand under the tutelage of Pinto Larson who had plied the trade in his youth before settling down to ranching Dolores Alconda, an orphan from Santa Fe now the schoolteacher in the village of San Miguel finds an extraordinary affinity with Dave's own self-elected banishment from family together they form a loving relationship and plan a wedding expecting to settle and prosper on a small cattle holding provided by Pinto Larson life's game of luck is fleeting

in *The Ghost Breaker* Charles Goddard and Paul Dickey curate a compendium that traverses the spectral and the mysterious resonating with an eerie elegance that captures the gothic and supernatural allure of storytelling this anthology juxtaposes a multitude of styles ranging from spine-chilling tales of the supernatural to more nuanced introspective narratives that explore the human psyche through its stories readers are introduced to entities that transcend the ordinary challenging conceptual boundaries and inviting a philosophical reflection on the nature of fear and what it means to confront the unknown Goddard and Dickey bring together an eclectic group of authors whose voices interweave to create a tapestry of haunting narratives emphasizing cultural and historical diversities the anthology draws on influences from various literary movements such as romanticism and realism this collection not only encapsulates the essence of these traditions but also reinterprets them through contemporary lenses the authors' diverse backgrounds enrich the thematic complexity offering a unique insight into the universal human fascination with the supernatural this anthology is a treasure trove for seekers of both the macabre and the thought-provoking it provides a rare opportunity to engage with a multiplicity of perspectives encouraging readers to ponder the intersection of fiction, reality and fear whether for academic exploration or leisurely reading *The Ghost Breaker* promises an illuminating journey through its varied thematic and stylistic landscapes fostering a dialogue that transcends the confines of the pages

passionately satirical and sharply observant he is one of the most interesting of our playwrights Sunday Telegraph *The Dead Monkey* Darke has

something both hilarious and horrific to say about the decay of a marriage and he compels the attention while doing so sunday telegraph the king of prussia a meaty play seethes with life wit and ideas darke give shape to a cornish identity that feels vital and real and has nothing to do with clay pipes and clotted cream like cornwall s coves it has many unexpected depths it also raises questions about the points where justice conscience and the law part company financial times the body the best moments in nick darke s play are extremely good and not all good in the same way the most obvious debt is to brecht there are other reminiscences of auden and isherwood s the dog beneath the skin of tom stoppard s after magritte and of t s eliot s verse plays tin tang mine a lament for an industry and a way of life but this should not suggest anything sentimental the writing is rugged and muscular lyrical but not ornate vigorous but not folksy oddball quirkily parochial and as authentic as a slice of rough bread the times

this collection examines the effects of slavery and emancipation on race class and gender in societies of the american south the caribbean latin america and west africa the contributors discuss what slavery has to teach us about patterns of adjustment and change black identity and the extent to which enslaved peoples succeeded in creating a dynamic world of interaction between the americas they examine how emancipation was defined how it affected attitudes towards slavery patterns of labour usage and relationships between workers as well as between workers and their former owners

when thelma and louise outfought the men who had tormented them women across america discovered what male fans of action movies have long known the empowering rush of movie violence yet the duo s escapades also provoked censure across a wide range of viewers from conservatives who felt threatened by the up ending of women s traditional roles to feminists who saw the pair s use of male style violence as yet another instance of women s co option by the patriarchy in the first book length study of violent women in movies reel knockouts makes feminist sense of violent women in films from hollywood to hong kong from top grossing to direct to video and from cop action movies to x rated skin flicks contributors from a variety of disciplines analyze violent women s respective places in the history of cinema in the lives of viewers and in the feminist response to male violence against women the essays in part one genre films turn to film cycles in which violent women have routinely appeared the essays in part two new bonds and new communities analyze movies singly or in pairs to determine how women s movie brutality fosters solidarity amongst the characters or their audiences all of the contributions look at films not simply in terms of whether they properly represent women or feminist principles but also as texts with social contexts and possible uses in the re construction of masculinity and femininity

When Julian's parents make the heartbreaking decision to send him and his two brothers away from Cuba to Miami via the Pedro Pan operation the boys are thrust into a new world where bullies run rampant and it's not always clear how best to protect themselves 90 miles to Havana is a 2011 Pura Belpré Honor Book for narrative and a 2011 Bank Street Best Children's Book of the Year
