narrativizing theories i dive into ambiguity and aesthetics to depict how clashing worldviews
exist side by side yet remain mutually incompatible i examine how cultures distinguish
between acceptable and unacceptable beliefs embodiments and identities and i outline an

provisionality of knowledge and the narrativization of reality
