you will learn how to avoid the inherent pitfalls of the first adam mentality to overcome today's trials and tribulations the more you understand the book of revelation the more you will be disarmed of the fears intimidations rhetoric and flood of information spewing from the dragon's mouth this overflow of propaganda has kept the human family afraid to even read the book of revelation when in fact it is the only book in the bible that declares a built in blessing to those who read and understand it
