

# The Stowaway A Tale Of California Pirates

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when a pirate terrorizes the 1818 california coast a brave young boy summons up the courage to defend his monterey home from a savage attack by the author of jimmy spoon and the pony express

in 1818 carlito an eleven year old boy in the spanish owned town of monterey california sees his quiet life threatened when the argentinian privateer hippolyte de bouchard attacks with his pirate ships

with the suspense of a thriller and the moral resonance of a joseph conrad classic the stowaway is an adventure story of the highest caliber a profound tale of good and evil all the more moving because it is based on actual events when two romanian stowaways show themselves on the container ship maersk dubai one day into its passage across the atlantic ocean bosun rodolfo miguel escorts them to his captain assuming they ll be fed and put to work to his horror and that of the rest of the crew the officers order the men to be put onto a flimsy raft which in an instant is sucked under the frigid unforgiving water over the next few weeks the crew is divided between those loyal to the officers and those who cannot accept what they have seen when on a later voyage a third stowaway is found and then another they re forced to come to terms with the earlier murders and at the risk of their own lives act for good or evil intercut with these events is the backstory of the desperate stowaways forced to flee their impoverished country in search of a better life the powerful resolution of these two narratives of the stowaways and the crew makes for a tense and heart pounding tale of murder fear and courage on the high seas
