works of political and social theory made her seem as much a threat outside her beloved france as within it while her friendship with statesmen soldiers and literary figures such as byron fanny burney goethe and schiller simply added to her dangerous celebrity she preached the virtues of liberalism and freedom wherever she went turning the experiences of her enforced absence into an arsenal to use against all who tried to suppress her even napoleon perhaps her greatest foe conceded from his own exile on st helena that she would last her unremitting activity as a speaker and writer made her into precisely the sort of activist no woman at that time was permitted to be yet she paradoxically remained a reluctant feminist seeming even to connive at the inferior status society granted her sex at the same time as vociferously challenging it and remaining torn by the conflicting demands of public and private life
