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now a major motion picture this landmark case study of three schizophrenic patients offers a rare and eccentric journey into madness shining a light on the ethical dilemmas of institutionalized care in the mid 20th century slate on july 1 1959 at

ypsilanti state hospital in michigan the social psychologist milton rokeach brought together three paranoid schizophrenics clyde benson an elderly farmer and alcoholic joseph cassel a failed writer who was institutionalized after increasingly violent behavior toward his family and leon gabor a college dropout and veteran of world war ii the men had one thing in common each believed himself to be jesus christ their extraordinary meeting and the two years they spent in one another's company serves as the basis for an investigation into the nature of human identity belief and delusion that is poignant amusing and at times disturbing displaying the sympathy and subtlety of a gifted novelist rokeach draws us into the lives of three troubled and profoundly different men who find themselves confronted with the ultimate contradiction conceivable for human beings more than one person claiming the same identity

when a loved one is struck with psychosis people often misunderstand what is happening and why they may feel helpless or confused or frightened not knowing what to do with or for the sufferer or how to handle the situation themselves this book takes a look at psychosis and how it has been handled over the last century or so beginning with a definition of psychosis and moving to a consideration of how people who suffer from it were once institutionalized and are now expected to be cared for at home the author traces the challenges families and communities face considers the plight of sufferers and what they experience and offers case examples throughout to illustrate the onset of psychosis the infringement it makes on personal and professional life and the toll it takes on sufferers and caregivers alike capps covers the magnitude of the problem the treatment of sufferers the warning signs facts and realities of recovery treatments prevention and coping strategies for family members and caregivers readers will come away from this work with a better understanding of psychosis in the context in which it occurs and what to do for themselves and their loved one as they navigate daily life the mental health system and family dynamics

blending neuroscience and ruminations on the creation and limits of reality a remarkable investigation of disorders of the mind and how we experience them in the man who lost his head douwe draaisma explores some of the most bizarre and

intriguing brain disorders throughout history from patients who believe their loved ones have been replaced by doubles or who feel an arm stretched out sideways that was amputated years ago to those who insist they're dead or have had their heads replaced these cases reveal the mind's complex way of imposing order amid chaos draaisma examines syndromes like cotard's and capgras where sufferers' perceptions of self and reality are radically altered linking delusions to specific brain circuits and cultural context with engaging storytelling and sharp insights he offers a captivating look at the human mind's remarkable and often mysterious workings

deals with the subject of schizophrenia and other psychotic disorders with more than 600 entries this work features a foreword and an introduction and references and appendixes its coverage includes the history treatment diagnosis and medical research and theories regarding this class of mental illness

the thread running through this collection of essays is the inviolate marriage between philosophy and psychology psychotherapist mary capocefalo has written long before psychologists were asking questions about mind and behavior philosophers were expressing the same curiosity the socratic method of teaching by asking questions is indispensable in psychotherapy aristotle spoke about happiness as though he had read twentieth century psychological research on the subject albert camus reduced the study of philosophy to a single psychological issue suicide conversely sigmund freud and carl jung addressed the question of the meaning of life lawrence kohlberg and john robert coles investigated moral behavior

and viktor frankl integrated existentialism into the practice of psychotherapy east is east and west is west and never the twain shall meet does not apply to philosophy and psychology

oh no not another philosophy book after twenty six centuries of reflecting and writing what can be said about philosophy that hasn't already been said this book is different because it is written for students who are not interested in philosophy or who are struggling to understand it professor malikow makes it easy to understand the sophisticated ideas and profound truths of philosophy by his use of everyday language analogies examples and stories mixed with a bit of humor

delusions of electronic persecution have been a preeminent symptom of psychosis for over two hundred years in the technical delusion jeffrey sponce traces the history and continuing proliferation of this phenomenon from its origins in enlightenment anatomy to our era of global interconnectivity while psychiatrists have typically dismissed such delusions of electronic control as arbitrary or as mere reflections of modern life sponce demonstrates a more complex and interdependent history of electronics power and insanity drawing on a wide array of psychological case studies literature court cases and popular media sponce analyzes the material and social processes that have shaped historical delusions of electronic contamination implantation telepathy surveillance and immersion from the age of telegraphy to contemporary digitality the media emerged within such delusions to become the privileged site for imagining the merger of electronic and political power serving as a paranoid conduit between the body and the body politic looking to the future sponce argues that this symptom will become increasingly difficult to isolate especially as remote and often secretive powers work to further integrate bodies electronics and information

perhaps no declaration incites more theological and moral outrage than a human s claim to be divine those who make this claim in ancient jewish and christian mythology are typically represented as the most hubristic and dangerous tyrants their horrible punishments are predictable and still serve as morality tales in religious communities today but not all self deifiers are saddled with pride and fated to fall some who claimed divinity stated a simple and direct truth though reviled on earth misunderstood and even killed they received vindication and rose to the stars this book tells the stories of six self deifiers in their historical social and ideological contexts in the history of interpretation the initial three figures have been demonized as cosmic rebels the first human adam lucifer later identified with satan and yaldabaoth in gnostic mythology by contrast the final three have served as positive models for deification and divine favor jesus in the gospel of john simon of samaria and allogenes in the nag hammadi library in the end the line separating demonization from deification is dangerously thin drawn as it is by the unsteady hand of human valuation

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
