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this memoir presents author elvin bells recollection of his own history and of his encounters with some of the most well known movers and shakers of the times he provides us with astonishing revelations based upon his discussions meetings and casual conversations with them the event makers ive known shares incredible close ups of everyone from president richard nixon and his secretary rosemary woods to elvis presley and screen siren marilyn monroe bell reveals shocking details of the love affair between woods and the interior secretary and describes the impetuosity of general william westmoreland among other stories in addition to sharing stories of the famous people he has known he tells his own personal stories including the tragic story of his grandmothers death within just a few minutes of his mothers birth in a fire that engulfed the hospital in flames he talks about the daring rescue of his mother by the young doctor who delivered her rescue that cost the doctor his eyesight his occupation and eventually his life he also shares fascinating

stories of the hardships ingenuity and perseverance that many parents and grandparents endured on their dust bowl quest to reach california in his tenth book the event makers ive known bell takes readers on an emotional roller coaster ride of superstar meltdowns victories and heartfelt personal stories

in these wondrously strange and revealing stories tom kealey chronicles the struggles and triumphs of the young and marginalized as they discover many ways of growing up their names are merrill omar shelby laika winston and toomey but most people don t see them they are boxers in training and the children of fishermen they are altar boys in a poverty stricken parish they are assistant groundskeepers and assistant camel keepers they travel with the circus care for disabled siblings steal police cars and retrieve the stolen boots of a priest ranging in abode from puget sound washington to pamlico sound north carolina they are abandoned yet courageous and plucky children and teenagers living on the edges of society thieves i ve known is a collection of powerful moving stories about the lives of a redemptive and peculiar cast of young characters who become easy to know and difficult to forget

action packed fast paced and captivating i ve known since i was eight tells the story of a down to earth teenage girl s first lesbian relationship and the reactions of her family friends and community sarah goldberg is a high school student who has known she was gay since she was eight with a little help from her bisexual friend jarod and her grandmother s love she forms a friendship with the girl of her dreams and they ultimately get involved sarah s new relationship forces her to finally deal with coming out to family friends and ultimately the entire school as sarah grows stronger in herself and in her identity as a lesbian she deals with homophobia threats of violence as well as a surprising amount of tolerance and support a must have on any young adult reading list this book is sure to be a hit for readers both gay and straight

he was born right at the beginning of the swinging 1960s in london england his family strive to make ends meet but for a variety of reasons a few short years later they move back to catholic ireland with his two irish parents and one sister there wasn t much happening in ireland those days but tumultuous changes were in the offing as backwoods ireland was to be transformed into a model of economic and social ideals in many ways the author s story reflects these events as both he and his country are carried along by the tidal wave of progression this tale follows him from cosmopolitan london to the most rural of ireland s green pastures into small towns and then its capital dublin in this his first book he attempts to tell his life s story with not only his country but also the whole wide world as a backdrop to show more clearly the astonishing advancements and the terrible incongruity of mankind as it contrives to kill maim and starve each other alongside the destruction of our beautiful planet and in this he readily identifies the complex nature of his own character that mirrors in many ways the awful truth about the human condition it is this duality of his nature that has brought him to this point in his life to where he stands now today all of what s contained between these sheets is factual but the author fervently wishes they weren t but as with the tidal ebb life goes on and with it hope and love

jewish pianist composer irving fields formed one of the first piano bass drum trios in jazz going on to compose song performed by frank sinatra louis

armstrong xavier cugat guy lombardo dinah shore sarah vaughan and others in 1959 made history by fusing latin and jazz music on his album bagels and bongos followed by a series of albums fusing jazz with world rhythms and his legacy was set irving died in 2016 at age 101 in his 90 s his wrote this autobiography about his life with the help of huffington post columnist and former music store owner tony sachs it was edited by music writer aaron joy with an introduction by cocktail pianist albert aprigliano
