winner of the 2022 north american society for sport history book award the early history of soccer in the united states has received relatively little scholarly attention while the sport's failure to make cultural inroads has been the source of much reflection and retrospection other pastimes such as baseball basketball and american football have been covered far more extensively soccer frontiers helps to fill this gap and correct the widespread notion that soccer was unfamiliar in the united states before the late twentieth century editors chris bolsmann and george n kioussis's collection sheds light on america's little known soccer history by focusing on the game's presence in major american cities between 1863 and 1913 as waves of immigrants arrived and american cities began to industrialize and become sizable cultural hubs soccer too began to flourish with essays focused on the years between the civil war and world war i a period which saw the creation of both the english football association and the us soccer federation this volume also offers diverse regional representation moving from new england to the south to the west coast soccer frontiers seeks to identify the distinctive yet understudied traits of american soccer thereby contributing an important missing piece to the broader puzzle of american sport history chris bolsmann is a professor in the department of kinesiology at california state university northridge he is coauthor with dilwyn porter english gentlemen and world soccer corinthians amateurism and the global game and coeditor of two books with peter alegi africa's world cup critical reflections on play patriotism spectatorship and space and south africa and the global game football apartheid and beyond george n kioussis is an assistant professor in the department of kinesiology at california state university northridge his work has appeared in the journal of sport history sport in history the international review for the sociology of sport and soccer society he currently serves as an editor for sport in history

it was the american menace according to the scottish and english newspapers of the 1920s the best players in the scottish leagues were being drawn to american companies that offered good jobs in return for playing on the company soccer team the resulting squads many of them ethnic beat the best teams in the world at that time this period from 1921 to 1931 were the golden years of american soccer with the skyrocketing economic prosperity of the united states and its corollary flood of new immigrants to america s shores came interest in soccer as a new form of sports entertainment it grew rapidly around northeastern industrial towns like fall river massachusetts and bethlehem pennsylvania as with the popular north american soccer league of the 1970s and 80s and its imported stars like pele the american soccer league of the 1920s bid for the best soccer players in the world creating a competitive fertile environment for the growth of soccer unfortunately few detailed records remain about these great teams and players league records were lost after w w ii and newspaper coverage was concentrated in smaller cities many of the league s heretofore unknown players possess no first name in print and the unfortunate losers of matches and league championship games often went unreported altogether during the later tougher years of the depression many of the foreign players hunkered down in jobs or returned to their native countries the disbanded american soccer league was revived under the same name but very different circumstances in 1933 but never reached the same level of skill as during the 1920s american soccer league 1921 1931 is the result of colin jose s tireless determination to provide accurate history of soccer s evolution in the united states soccer was one of the most popular sports in the united states during the 1920s often drawing huge crowds in relatively small towns to see the world s best

players compete documented through thousands of newspaper clipp

this narrative of u s soccer s history and present day status addresses the issues of socioeconomics emphasizing the differences between social classes in u s soccer past and present as well as those between american soccer and international football this work analyzes the role of class in american soccer s failure to carve out a more prominent place in the sports landscape contemporary soccer is explored from its beginnings in informal parks and recreation leagues to the development of formal club programs and university professional and u s national teams in recent decades hispanic leagues formed primarily by mexican and central american immigrants have reinforced the theme of a class based exclusionary space in u s soccer a personal perspective based on the authors experience coaching soccer at the informal level broadens the book s appeal

gene ventriglia was a very poor fourteen year old immigrant when he arrived in new york harbor in early july 1958 coming from the tiny village of alife italy he had grown up in a farm village of about three hundred inhabitants the village as well as his parents house had been leveled by bombs in the final days of world war ii in 1958 the memories were still very much alive as postwar reconstruction was far from completion these were the surroundings where gene ventriglia grew up gene had only known his small village and was unaware that common items such as telephones and tv sets even existed one can only imagine his reaction upon seeing the new york skyscrapers and the size and number of cars when he first walked on the new york streets he had no idea how his life would change in the very near future how would he react he wondered if he would make friends after all how would he communicate he did not know a word of english gene soon realized that getting a good education was the key to success however he also realized that it would take great efforts and motivation on his part was he willing to put in the necessary effort he needed to learn a new language in a community where he only heard italian his search to find that american dream lasted more than sixty years during this time gene was faced with one challenge after another in his search for that dream in each case gene used his passion for the game of soccer to fuel his inner motivation and determination not to give up every time he arrived at a dead end gene s path to finding that dream was full of surprises in all cases he was very determined and he demonstrated outstanding motivation to achieve his goal
