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there was once a village bred by evil on the barren coast of cornwall england lived a community who prayed for shipwrecks a community who lured storm tossed ships to crash upon the sharp rocks of their shore they fed and clothed themselves with the loot salvaged from the wreckage dead sailors tools and trinkets became decorations for their homes most never questioned their murderous way of life then upon that pirates shore crashed the ship the isle of skye and the youngest of its

crew members 14 year old john spencer survived the wreck but would he escape the wreckers this is his harrowing tale

today on the keys between key west and the mainland some forty thousand residents and thousands of visitors fish swim sail and dive into the crystal clear waters off a tropical reef relax in the sun and cooling trade wind breezes and sleep in the air conditioned comfort of their homes and hotel rooms on these same islands as short a time as eighty years ago fewer than three hundred inhabitants tried to eke out a living without benefit of electricity running water radios or telephones the stories of these hard pioneers and their predecessors as far back as the native americans who lived on the keys at least one thousand years ago are told many for the first time in this book

a history of the drama and danger of wrecking since the eighteenth century and the often grisly ingenuity of british wreckers scavengers of the sea a fine wreck has always represented sport pleasure treasure and in many cases the difference between living well and just getting by in settings ranging from the goodwin sands to the wreck strewn waters off the coast of durham these murky tales of resourcefulness and quick witted opportunism open a vista of life at the rough edges

in the wreckers a literary voyage by francis lynde readers are transported to the heart of the american west through the adventurous lens of jimmie dodds upon visiting the pioneer short line railway post construction jimmie encounters a cadre of compelling characters that navigate the rugged world of railroads amid economic upheavals and moral ambiguities lynde's prose effortlessly melds a spirited narrative with poignant observations reminiscent of the naturalistic style that emerged in american literature in the early twentieth century the novel's insightful exploration of human nature against the backdrop of technological progress positions it as a salient piece within the genre of adventure fiction nfrancis lynde's background as an engineer undoubtedly informed his vivid portrayal of the railway's operational intricacies and the societal impacts of industrial expansion the authenticity of the wreckers stems from lynde's real life experiences coupled with his narrative flair making his work resound with the pragmatic details of construction life while capturing its romantic allure his expertise is fused with a wry sense of humor evidenced in his character's skepticism about hunches and their unreliable forecasting analogous to the unpredictable turns of fate within the tale n the wreckers is recommended for enthusiasts of historical adventure novels seeking a storied journey across a bygone era of american industry lynde's unique blend of professional knowledge and narrative artistry crafts an absorbing tale that
