when people experience a traumatic event such as war or the threat of annihilation they often turn to history for stories that promise a positive outcome to their suffering during world war ii the french took comfort in the story of joan of arc and her heroic efforts to rid france of foreign occupation to bring the joan narrative more into line with current circumstances however popular retellings modified the original story so that what people believed took place in the past was often quite different from what actually occurred paul a cohen identifies this interplay between story and history as a worldwide phenomenon found in countries of radically different cultural religious and social character he focuses here on serbia israel china france the soviet union and great britain all of which experienced severe crises in the twentieth century and in response appropriated age old historical narratives that resonated with what was happening in the present to serve a unifying restorative purpose a central theme in the book is the distinction between popular memory and history although vitally important to historians this distinction is routinely

blurred in people's minds and the historian's truth often cannot compete with the power of a compelling story from the past even when it has been seriously distorted by myth or political manipulation Cohen concludes by suggesting that the patterns of interaction he probes given their near universality may well be rooted in certain human propensities that transcend cultural difference

the conventional wisdom about historical memory is summed up in George Santayana's celebrated phrase those who cannot remember the past are condemned to repeat it today the consensus that it is moral to remember immoral to forget is nearly absolute and yet is this right David Rieff an independent writer who has reported on bloody conflicts in Africa the Balkans and Central Asia insists that things are not so simple he poses hard questions about whether remembrance ever truly has or indeed ever could inoculate the present against repeating the crimes of the past he argues that rubbing raw historical wounds whether self inflicted or imposed by outside forces neither remedies injustice nor confers reconciliation if he is right then historical memory is not a moral imperative but rather a moral option sometimes called for sometimes not collective remembrance can be toxic sometimes Rieff concludes it may be more moral to forget ranging widely across some of the defining conflicts of modern times the Irish Troubles and the Easter Uprising of 1916 the White Settlement of Australia the American Civil War the Balkan Wars the Holocaust and 9/11 Rieff presents a pell-mell examination of the uses and abuses of historical memory his contentious brilliant and elegant essay is an indispensable work of moral philosophy
