at the end of the civil war union general william tecumseh sherman was surprisingly more popular in the newly defeated south than he was in the north yet only thirty years later his name was synonymous with evil and destruction in the south particularly as the creator and enactor of the total war policy in demon of the lost cause wesley moody examines these perplexing contradictions and how they and others function in past and present myths about sherman throughout this fascinating study of sherman s reputation from his first public servant role as the major general for the state of california until his death in 1891 moody explores why sherman remains one of the most controversial figures in american history

using contemporary newspaper accounts sherman's letters and memoirs as well as biographies of sherman and histories of his times moody reveals that sherman's shifting reputation was formed by whoever controlled the message whether it was the lost cause historians of the south sherman's enemies in the north or sherman himself with his famous march to the sea in georgia the general became known for inventing a brutal warfare where the conflict is brought to the civilian population in fact many of sherman's actions were official tactics to be employed when dealing with guerrilla forces yet sherman never put an end to the talk of his innovative tactics and even added to the stories himself sherman knew he had enemies in the union army and within the republican elite who could and would jeopardize his position for their own gain in fact these were the same people who spread the word that sherman was a southern sympathizer following the war helping to place the general in the south's good graces that all changed however when the lost cause historians began formulating revisions to the civil war as sherman's actions were the perfect explanation for why the south had lost demon of the lost cause reveals the machinations behind the sherman myth and the reasons behind the acceptance of such myths no matter who invented them in the case of sherman's own mythmaking moody postulates that his motivation was to secure a military position to support his wife and children for the other sherman mythmakers personal or political gain was typically the rationale behind the stories they told and believed in tracing sherman's ever changing reputation moody sheds light on current and past understanding of the civil war through the lens of one of its most controversial figures

at west point william babcock hazen made a life long enemy of custer by arresting him and during the civil war he made enemies of rosecrans and sheridan after the war grant came to hate him these men accused hazen of stealing of cowardice in the face of the enemy of causing the loss at chickamauga of being a dupe of the indians and they banished him to fort buford in the far northwest hazen's life debunks the myth of men who fought side by side bonding together into a brotherhood hazen also had running feuds with two secretaries of war he caused one to be impeached and the other to be publicly disgraced even sherman after years of friendship turned against hazen

today the saxophone is an emblem of cool and the instrument most closely associated with jazz yet not long ago it was derided as the siren of satan and it was largely ignored in the united states for well over half a century after its invention when it was first widely heard it was often viewed as a novelty noisemaker not a real musical instrument in only a few short years however saxophones appeared in music shops across america and became one of the most important instrumental voices how did the saxophone get from comic to cool bandleader tom brown claimed that it was his saxophone sextet the six brown brothers who inaugurated the craze while this boast was perhaps more myth than reality the group was indisputably one of the most famous musical acts on stage in the early twentieth century starting in traveling circuses small time vaudeville and minstrel shows the group trekked across the united states and europe bringing this new sound to the american public through their live performances and groundbreaking recordings the first discs of a saxophone ensemble in general circulation the six brown brothers played a crucial role in making this new instrument familiar to and loved by a wide audience in that moaning saxophone author and cornet player bruce vermazen sifts fact from legend in this craze and tells the remarkable story of these six musical brothers william tom alec percy vern and fred vermazen traces the brothers path through minstrelsy the circus burlesque vaudeville and broadway
