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nineteenth century europe abounds with conspiracy both ghastly and mysterious jesuits plot against freemasons italian priests are strangled with their own intestines french criminals plan bombings by day and celebrate black masses by night every nation has its own secret service perpetrating forgeries plots and massacres but what if behind all of these conspiracies lies just one man

ours is an age of offense a time of reactionary shock always received never given ours is an age that has forgone cultural

sefer brantshpigl is an important yiddish religious ethical work first published in cracow 1596 it was reprinted six more times into the beginning of the eighteenth century and is an important source for the social and religious life of central east european jewry in the early modern period this volume is the first complete translation of this text into english with annotations and scholarly introduction the author moshe henochs altschul yerushalmi was a member of what has become to be known as the secondary intelligentsia little is known about his life other than that he lived in prague his son henoch altschul was the shamash of the jewish community of prague from 1603 1633 he examined all aspects of jewish social and religious life in seventy six chapters each chapter discusses a specific topic not only does he describe what is good and critiques what he finds to be lacking but he buttresses his arguments with citations from the whole range of rabbinic literature one aspect that is particularly interesting is his citation of kabbalistic sources in his arguments he cites kabbalistic sources more than sixty times and even devotes a whole chapter to the kabbalistic night ritual of tikkun hazot

on the impulse behind cartographies marjorie agosín writes i have always wanted to understand the meaning of displacement and the quest or longing for home in these lyrical meditations in prose and poetry agosín evokes the many places on four continents she has visited or called home recording personal and spiritual voyages the author opens herself to follow the ambiguous secret map of her memory which does not betray agosín s journey begins in chile where she spent her childhood before her family left in the early days of the pinochet dictatorship of santiago agosín writes day and night i think about my city i dream the dream of all exiles agosín also travels to prague and vienna ancestral homes of her grandparents and to valparaíso in chile which received them as immigrants kneeling among the yellow mounds at the terezin concentration camp where twenty two of her relatives died agosín places small stones shrubs the stuff of life on graves i did not recognize and then on through the middle east the mediterranean europe and the americas everywhere she is drawn to women in whose devotion and creativity she sees a deep vein of hope from julia keeper of the synagogue at rhodes to the women potters in the chilean town of pomaire agosín writes of diaspora exile and oppression yet only to highlight the dignity and valor of those who find refuge in their humanity and their art in community and tradition cartographies shows us what can be found when we journey with openness as approachable to strangers as we are to ourselves

hitherto there has been no book that attempted to sum up the breadth of umberto eco s work and its importance for the study of semiotics communication and cognition there have been anthologies and overviews of eco s work within eco studies sometimes works in semiotics have used aspects of eco s work yet thus far there has been no overview of the work of eco in the breadth of semiotics this volume is a contribution to both semiotics and eco studies the 40 scholars who participate in the volume come from a variety of disciplines but have all chosen to work with a favorite quotation from eco that they find particularly illustrative of the issues that his work raises some of the scholars have worked exegetically placing the quotation within a tradition others have determined the epistemic value of the quotation and offered a critique while still others have seen the quotation as a starting point for conceptual developments within a field of application however each article within this volume points toward the relevance of eco for contemporary studies concerning semiotics communication and cognition

the philosophy of umberto eco stands out in the library of living philosophers series as the volume on the most interdisciplinary scholar hitherto and probably the most widely translated the italian philosopher s name and works are well known in the humanities both his philosophical and literary works being translated into fifteen or more languages eco is a founder of modern

semiotics and widely known for his work in the philosophy of language and aesthetics he is also a leading figure in the emergence of postmodern literature and is associated with cultural and mass communication studies his writings cover topics such as advertising television and children's literature as well as philosophical questions bearing on truth reality cognition language and literature the critical essays in this volume cover the full range of this output this book has wide appeal not only because of its interdisciplinary nature but also because of eco's famous high and low approach which is deeply scholarly in conception and very accessible in outcome the short essay why philosophy included in the volume is exemplary in this regard it will appeal to scholars for its wit and to high school students for its intelligibility

after much investigation ziolkowski reinforces umberto eco's notion that the most powerful secret the magnetic center of conspiracy fiction is in fact a secret without content

renowned historian essayist and journalist david a bell has long made france and its history the subject of his scholarly gaze and the object of his enduring affection shadows of revolution reflections on france past and present gathers together his writing composed over a period of more than 25 years into a single volume as the title of this collection suggests bell views much of french history through the lens of the revolutionary era within a space of a dozen years from bastille to bonaparte the country experimented with and experienced every form of governance creating in the process as bell puts it the most intense political laboratory the world had ever known the revolution remains the country's defining era delineating its sense of identity and overshadowing the events that followed it yet another bell argues is the vichy period and world war two france's dark night of the soul with whose legacies the country continues to contend these two moments of violent and transformative upheaval may dominate french history but as this collection and bell's observational powers reveal the full range of topics involving france is endlessly rich and diverse divided into eight sections it connects france's education to its national identity the enlightenment to the revolution and human rights napoleon to victor hugo and nineteenth century anti semitism to such recent events such as the riots of 2006 the arab spring and the charlie hebdo tragedy shadows of revolution embodies and reflects the endlessly fascinating and entertaining complexity of french history and shows the ways in which it has shaped world history

values across cultures and times is a collection of sixteen articles examining the concept of values understood in its broadest sense as the need of the modern man to examine redefine and reconstruct previous theories histories moralities social relationships forms of language and language use in times of great change preserving traditional values seems to be particularly difficult and the authors of these essays respond to the challenge and approach the notion of changing values from the

perspectives of literary studies and linguistics the book opens with an introductory overview followed by sixteen articles divided into three sections the book is aimed at a broad academic audience while the popular style of the articles also makes the volume appealing to a wider audience interested in different aspects of values the authors of the articles come from serbia macedonia bulgaria romania and the united states

czech american timeline chronicles important events bearing on czech american history from the earliest known entry of a czech on american soil to date this comprehensive chronology depicts the dazzling epic history of czech colonists settlers as well as early visitors and their descendants starting in 1519 with hernn corts soldier johann berger in mexico and in 1528 the jchymov miners in haiti through the escapades of bohemian jesuits in latin america in the 17th and 18th centuries the bohemian and moravian pioneer settlers in new amsterdam new york in the 17th century and the extraordinary mission work of moravian brethren in the 18th century to the mass migration of czechs from the habsburg empire in the second half of the 19th and the early part of the 20th centuries and the contemporary exodus of czechs from nazism and communism historically this is the first serious undertaking of its kind this is an invaluable reference to all researchers and students of czech american history as well as to professionals and amateurs of czech american genealogy and to individuals interested in immigration and cultural history in general

the book deals with the formative years of israel s evolving symbolic landscape 1904 1967 it covers the stories of a few dozen jews who passed away in the diaspora and later their remains were taken to be buried for the second time and sometimes for the third in israel these were zionists and politicians writers and poets heroes and public activists whose common denominator was that they all passed away in the diaspora far and detached from the national homeland that they fought for before their tragic death only later in an act of repair their coffins were sent to be buried in the sacred zionist soil in jerusalem tel aviv or dgania these graves became pilgrimage sites and contributed to the design of israel s landscape the book examines how and why such great effort was made to bring their remains to israel for reinterment and how the funerals and graves of the public figures became state symbols and national instruments for establishing israeli sovereignty over the land

this anthology of scholarship on jewish women writers is the first to focus on what it is to be a woman and a jew and to explore how the two identities variously support and oppose each other the collection is part of a growing scholarship that reflects the enormous output of writing by jewish women since the second wave of the women s movement in the 1970s

the author explores the phenomenon of the jewish culture in europe in this book she asks in what way do non jews embrace and enact jewish culture and for what reasons

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
