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women crime and justice balancing the scales presents a comprehensive analysis of the role of women in the criminal justice system providing important new insight to their position as offenders victims and practitioners draws on global feminist perspectives on female offending and victimization from around the world covers topics including criminal law case processing domestic violence gay lesbian and transgendered prisoners cyberbullying offender re entry and sex trafficking explores issues professional women face in the criminal justice workplace such as police culture judicial decision making working in corrections facilities and more includes international case examples throughout using numerous topical examples and personal narratives to stimulate students critical thinking and active engagement

racism crime and justice offers a broad overview of this challenging and underexplored field the book synthesises a great deal of empirical research evidence documentary accounts and illustrative examples in order to give a minority perspective on the race and crime debate the book looks systematically at the influence of race in determining the prison population in influencing decisions by the courts in the function and behaviour of the police in the extent and nature of crime committed both by and against ethnic minorities the book ends by discussing policy issues and explores the options open in seeking to combat discrimination on racial grounds within the criminal justice system following the findings of the lawrence inquiry although specialist studies have appeared and there have been general texts containing chapter length summaries of the area there is no up to date textbook on this important theme

crime is a source of endless fascination and fear yet behind the apparent consensus that crime must be fought there is considerable conflict about what should or should not be treated as criminal and even the most shocking crimes can inspire divisive debate this concise book explores the seemingly simple common sense concept of crime revealing the huge complexities ambiguities and tensions that lie beneath it criminal law is often at odds with different moral perspectives and the practices of different cultures the mass media distort the picture profoundly as do politicians in pursuit of law and order votes the criminal justice system tackles only a limited range of crimes almost entirely ones committed by the poor and relatively powerless while often neglecting the most dangerous and harmful activities of corporations and states from the carnage of unjust wars to the tragedies engendered by austerity it is only by examining the multiple and varied perspectives on crime that we can begin to understand and respond appropriately to this social phenomenon written by a world leading criminologist this insightful book will be an invaluable and captivating introduction for students and interested readers of criminology law sociology and politics

crime and criminal justice provides students with a comprehensive and engaging introduction to the study of criminology by taking an interdisciplinary approach to explaining criminal behaviour and criminal justice the book is divided into two parts which address the two essential bases that form the discipline of criminology part one describes discusses and evaluates a range of theoretical approaches that have offered explanations for crime drawing upon contributions from the disciplines of sociology psychology and biology it then goes on to apply these theories to specific forms of criminality part two offers an accessible but detailed review of the major philosophical aims and sociological theories of punishment and examines the main areas of the contemporary criminal justice system including the police the courts and judiciary prisons and more recent approaches to punishment presenting a clear and thorough review of theoretical thinking on crime and of the context and current workings of the criminal justice system this book provides students with an excellent grounding in the study of criminology

this book adopts a critical criminological approach to analyze the production representation and role of crime in the emerging international order it analyzes the role of power and its influence on the dynamics of criminalization at an international level facilitating an examination of the geopolitics of international criminal justice such an approach to crime is well developed in domestic criminology however this critical approach is yet to be used to explore the relationship between power crime and justice in an international setting this book brings together contrasting opinions on how courts prosecutors judges ngos and other bodies act to reflexively produce the social reality of international justice in doing this it bridges the gaps between the fields of sociology criminology international relations political science and international law to explore the problems and prospects of international criminal justice and illustrate the role of crime and criminalization in a complex evolving and contested international society
