seven though they usually call them dispensations this author believes there are five which are basic to the story of our redemption the noahic abrahamic mosaic davidic and messianic only one of these is old and therefore obsolete only one is new but endorses the other three with this insight we can rightly divide the word of truth 2 timothy 2 15 niv has correctly handle see if you agree

but i m not a hebrew so why should i read a letter addressed to jewish believers because the author s warnings and appeals don t go back do go on are needed by christians teetering on the slippery slope of backsliding or simply standing still for the eager believer still running the race this letter offers a new perspective on both the old testament and the lord jesus it answers the crucial question where is he now and what is he doing people saw him as the prophet and will see him as the king but hebrews sees him as the priest we all need yet he is the same yesterday today and for ever

unlike paul s other letters this one is not addressed to particular churches or individuals with their own needs and problems even ephesians is not in all the early copies it is a circular despatch covering general matters of belief chapters 1 3 and behaviour chapters 4 6 applicable to all churches and christians everywhere it is one of the clearest statements in the new testament of god s purpose in saving us and is as practically challenging as it is spiritually inspiring perhaps that is why it is such a popular choice for preachers
