boris sergievsky was one of the most colorful of the early aviators he made his first flight less than ten years after the wright brothers made theirs he made his last only four years before the concorde took off born in russia sergievsky learned to fly in 1912 in world war i he became a much decorated infantry officer and then a fighter pilot battling the austro hungarians during the russian civil war that followed he fought on three fronts against the bolsheviks coming to america in 1923 the first job he could find in new york was with a pick and shovel digging the holland tunnel but he soon joined igor sikorsky s airplane company over the next decade as chief test pilot for the company he tested the sikorsky flying boats that pan american airways used to establish its world wide routes setting seventeen world aviation records along the way sergievsky also flew pioneering flights across unchartered african and latin american jungles in the 1930s flew with charles lindbergh tested early helicopters and jets and flew his own grumman mallard on charter flights

until 1965 through it all his sense of humor remained intact as did his passion for beautiful women

in seattle s women teachers of the interwar years doris pieroth describes the contributions of a remarkable group of women who dominated the seattle public school system in the early years of the twentieth century and helped to produce well educated citizens who were responsible for the widespread philanthropic volunteer and municipal activities that came to characterize the city while most publications on the history of education have emphasized theory or administration pieroth focuses on individual teachers set against the backdrop of a developing city the book provides vivid portraits of educated strong ambitious women making successful careers at a time when job opportunities for women were very limited pieroth interviewed as many of these women as she could find and quotes from the interviews enhance her lively well written narrative using details drawn from local newspapers and school publications she demonstrates that the influence of this cohort of women made modern seattle the livable place that it remains today seattle s women teachers of the interwar years is a significant contribution to the history of seattle and the region to women s history and to the history of education

industry in the 1980s the scope of the inquiry is broad encompassing the role of organized labor the changing racial composition of the industry s work force the creation of a feminine work culture and its as companies relocated their manufacturing facilities in the south they capitulated to the system of racial segregation after the passage of the civil rights act of 1964 the whiteness of occupations within the apparel industry declined and the racial and ethnic diversity of the industry increased african american and latina women workers accounted for a large percentage of what was once a predominantly white industry and as the ethnic and racial diversity of the southern clothing industry increased organizing efforts were more successful the influential union label and boycott strategies of the clothing industry provide an important perspective on the place of women workers in southern culture and the labor movement the role of women as the primary consumers of the family placed them in a critical position to influence the success or failure of boycotts union label programs and ultimately solidarity but as the united states apparel industry collapse began in the 1960s apparel unions chose to rely on buy american boycott campaigns that pitted them against the very workers they had hoped to organize
