anthems are symbolic means through which nations present themselves to the world accordingly creating seven new nation states out of the bones of yugoslavia required new anthems why did these new states opt for century old national songs or failing this for the anthems without words what are the images and symbols that each of these states chose as their national signatures and how were these chosen this book explores a variety of images of nationhood or the absence of them in the lyrics of the official anthems and of competing national songs and traces their historical trajectory from the time of their conception to their legal entrenchment this is the first full length study into the symbolic representations of nationhood in the recently created nation states of the balkans

postcolonial nation building he explores how state ideologues and mainstream intellectuals expanded their efforts by elevating the nation's youth as the core protagonist of a newly independent Korea by designating students and young men and women as the hope and exemplars of the new nation state the discursive stage was set for the remarkable outburst of the April Revolution in 1960 Kim's interpretation of this seminal event underscores student participants recasting of anticolonial resistance memories into South Korea's postcolonial politics this pivotal innovation enabled protestors to circumvent the state's official anticommunism and in doing so brought about the formation of a culture of protest that lay at the heart of the country's democracy movement from the 1960s to the 1980s the positioning of women as subordinates in the nation building enterprise is also shown to be a direct translation of postwar and cold war exigencies into the sphere of culture this cultural conservatism went on to shape the terrain of gender relations in subsequent decades a meticulously researched cultural history youth for nation illuminates the historical significance of the postwar period through a rigorous analysis of magazines films textbooks archival documents and personal testimonies in addition to scholars and students of twentieth century Korea the book will be welcomed by those interested in cold war cultures social movements and democratization in East Asia

Rosenberg was more than just a war poet a general failure to take this into consideration has contributed to the belated recognition of the distinctions of his work a working class London Jew he schooled himself long before the Great War to respond to issues of class culture art and poetry a combination of dependency and self sufficiency which sustains his mature work and which gave him a sense of himself as an Anglo Jewish poet to illuminate Rosenberg Nayef al Joulan considers the conditions of the Jewish community in the East End of London at the turn of the century and examines the writer's attitudes to the Zionism in vogue he also investigates striking echoes of Freudian psychology in Rosenberg's work tracing Rosenberg's working class literary heritage al Joulan underlines a modern Jewish insight that has parallels with Marx and Freud and therefore uncovers the role class and race played in the critical marginalising of Rosenberg the book concludes by examining Rosenberg's cognitive ekphrasis his idea of language as a vehicle for mental essence a perception rooted into the painter's mind

cultural grammars of nation diaspora and indigeneity in canada considers how the terms of critical debate in literary and cultural studies in canada have shifted with respect to race nation and difference in asking how indigenous and diasporic interventions have remapped these debates the contributors argue that a new cultural grammar is at work and attempt to sketch out some of the ways it operates the essays reference pivotal moments in canadian literary and cultural history and speak to ongoing debates about canadian nationalism postcolonialism migrancy and transnationalism topics covered include the asian race riots in vancouver in 1907 the cultural memory of internment and dispersal of japanese canadians in the 1940s the politics of migrant labour and the domestic labour scheme in the 1960s and the trial of robert pickton in vancouver in

2007 the contributors are particularly interested in how diaspora and indigeneity continue to contribute to this critical reconfiguration and in how conversations about diaspora and indigeneity in the canadian context have themselves been transformed cultural grammars is an attempt to address both the interconnections and the schisms between these multiply fractured critical terms as well as the larger conceptual shifts that have occurred in response to national and postnational arguments

this title was first published in 2000 recent years have seen tremendous economic and political changes in sub saharan africa the contributors to this volume focus on the pressing problem of how actors in their everyday life political and social action handle uncertainty with the help of rich empirical material from different countries in sub saharan africa the authors try to understand how actors react manoeuver organize and make their actions meaningful in an environment characterized by unpredictability and change

the book unravels the entangled relationship between ascriptive identity caste and space urban and how this interaction re moulds urban stratification urban rather represents a liminal space while offering promising opportunities to aspire and achieve upward mobility it presents structural constraints frustrating the march of dalits to claim desired mobility through descriptive and nuanced accounts of various aspects of dalit lives in urban it foregrounds how caste permeates everyday city life the book debunks the mirage of urban castelessness

writing in the cosmopolitan metropolis of baghdad alfarabi 870 950 is unique in the history of premodern political philosophy for his extensive discussion of the nation or umma in arabic the term umma may be traced back to the qur ān and signifies then and now both the islamic religious community as a whole and the various nations of which that community is composed such as the turks persians and arabs examining alfarabi s political writings as well as parts of his logical commentaries his book on music and other treatises alexander orwin contends that the connections and tensions between ethnic and religious ummas explored by alfarabi in his time persist today in the ongoing political and cultural disputes among the various nationalities within islam according to orwin alfarabi strove to recast the islamic umma as a community in both a religious and cultural sense encompassing art and poetry as well as law and piety by proposing to acknowledge and accommodate diverse ummas rather than ignoring or suppressing them alfarabi anticipated the contemporary concept of islamic civilization which emphasizes culture at least as much as religion enlisting language experts jurists theologians artists and rulers in his philosophic enterprise alfarabi argued for a new umma that would be less rigid and more creative than the

muslim community as it has often been understood and therefore less inclined to force disparate ethnic and religious communities into a single mold redefining the muslim community demonstrates how alfarabi s judicious combination of cultural pluralism religious flexibility and political prudence could provide a blueprint for reducing communal strife in a region that continues to be plagued by it today

nationalism and revolution in europe 1763 1848 addresses enduring historiographical problems concerning the appearance of the first national movements in europe and their role in the crises associated with the age of revolution considerable detail is supplied to the picture of enlightenment era intellectual and cultural pursuits in which the nation was featured as both an object of theoretical interest and site of practice in doing so the work provides a major corrective to depictions of the period characteristic of earlier ventures including those by authors as notable as hobsbawm gellner and anderson while offering an advance in narrative coherence by portraying how developments in the sphere of ideas influenced the terms of political debate in france and elsewhere in the years preceding the upheavals of 1789 1815 subsequent chapters explore the composite nature of the revolutions which followed and the challenges of determining the relative capacity of the three chief sources of contemporary

unrest constitutional national and social to inspire extra legal challenges to the restoration status quo

in this wide ranging work caspar hirschi offers new perspectives on the origins of nationalism and the formation of european nations based on extensive study of written and visual sources dating from the ancient to the early modern period the author re integrates the history of pre modern europe into the study of nationalism describing it as an unintended and unavoidable consequence of the legacy of roman imperialism in the middle ages hirschi identifies the earliest nationalists among renaissance humanists exploring their public roles and ambitions to offer new insight into the history of political scholarship in europe and arguing that their adoption of ancient role models produced massive contradictions between their self image and political function this book demonstrates that only through understanding the development of the politics scholarship and art of pre modern europe can we fully grasp the global power of nationalism in a modern political context
