best known for her internationally multi million copy bestselling novel flowers in the attic cleo virginia andrews lived a fascinating life born to modest means she came of age in the american south during the great depression and faced a series of increasingly challenging health issues yet once she rose to global literary fame she prided herself on her intense privacy this eye opening look at the life of virgina andrews reveals a new side of the enigmatic woman behind one of the most important novels of the twentieth century featuring family photographs interviews with close family members personal letters a partial manuscript of an unpublished novel and more the woman beyond the attic is perfect for v c andrews fans who pick up every new novel or those wanting to return to the favorite novelist of their adolescence

america has an array of women writers who have made history and many of them lived died and were buried in virginia b gothic novelists

writers of westerns and african american poets these writers include a pulitzer prize winner the first woman writer to be named poet laureate of the commonwealth of virginia and the first woman to top the best seller lists in the twentieth century mary roberts rinehart was a bestselling mystery author often called the american agatha christie anne spencer was an important figure in the harlem renaissance v c andrews was so popular that when she died a court ruled that her name was taxable and the poetry of susan archer talley weiss received praise from edgar allan poe professor and cemetery history enthusiast sharon pajka has written a guide to their accomplishments in life and to their final resting places

horror an increasingly popular subject for books television and movies is especially appealing to teenagers who are enthusiastic fans of ghouls and gore the appeal of horror literature to young adults cannot be denied or ignored and in presenting young adult horror fiction the first genre study in the twayne young adult authors series cosette kies concentrates on teenage interest in the field dr kies reminds us that the supernatural has a long literary tradition including such works as emily bronte s wuthering heights henry james s the turn of the screw and edgar allan poe s short stories against this literary background dr kies takes a witty and perceptive look at contemporary manifestations of horror fiction highlighting those authors that teenagers particularly enjoy writers such as v c andrews dean koontz john saul anne rice chelsea quinn yarbro robert bloch robert maccammon and of course stephen king are examined in depth each chapter includes an introduction that touches on historical antecedents a chronology of biographical highlights and major works for the subject author and a long quote that allows the writer s individual voice to shed light on his or her literary philosophy dr kies analyzes theme plot and character for the major works with perception and skill separate chapters explore the appeal of satanism for young adults in novels such as the exorcist and rosemary s baby and there is an irreverent look at a recent development in horror writing splatterpunk presenting young adult horror fiction is a welcome addition for all those interested in horror literature and will also provide much needed information for librarians teachers and parents who want to understand why young adults love horror literature

a description of about 1000 contemporary and classic titles in horror fiction there is background information on the history trends and appeal of the genre works are classified into 13 sub genres keywords are listed with each entry to lead users to related titles and awards are cited

swallowed audrina's childhood and now the sprawling victorian mansion threatens her adult life too audrina remembers a better time when her husband arden was a young man with a heart filled with devotion for her he didn't used to be this ambitious expansive this cruel but then the death of audrina's father changed a great many things when the reading of her father's will reveals that audrina herself will control fifty one percent of the family brokerage the halls of whitefern again don't feel safe arden's protestations become frantic nearly violent and while audrina didn't anticipate running the family business she's curious to do so and she can't help but wonder what had made her father change his will at the last minute what did he know about arden that she didn't trapped in the middle of it all her fragile simple sister the beautiful trusting sylvia audrina promised her father she'd watch over the young woman but after years of relative quiet the dark days of whitefern may have returned
