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why did collectors seek out posters and collect ephemera during the late nineteenth and the twentieth centuries how have such materials been integrated into institutional collections today what inspired collectors to build significant holdings of works from cultures other than their own and what are the issues facing curators and collectors of digital ephemera today these are among the questions tackled in this volume the first to examine the practices of collecting prints posters and ephemera during the modern and contemporary periods a wide range of case studies feature collections of printed materials from the united states latin america france germany great britain

china japan russia iran and cuba fourteen essays and one roundtable discussion all specially commissioned from art historians curators and collectors for this volume explore key issues such as the roles of class politics and gender and address historical contexts social roles value and national and transnational aspects of collecting practices the global scope highlights cross cultural connections and contributes to a new understanding of the place of prints posters and ephemera within an increasingly international art world

this book examines the historical context of museums their collections and the objects that form them susan m pearce probes the psychological and social reasons that people collect and identifies three modes of collecting collecting as souvenirs as fetishes and as systematic assemblages she considers how museum professionals set policies of collection management acquire study and exhibit objects and make meaning of the objects in their care pearce also explores the ideological relationship between museums and their collections and the intellectual and social relationships of museums to the public

the poster art advertising design and collecting 1860s–1900s is a cultural history that situates the poster at the crossroads of art design advertising and collecting though international in scope the book focuses especially on france and england ruth e iskin argues that the avant garde poster and the original art print played an important role in the development of a modernist language of art in the 1890s as well as in the adaptation of art to an era of mass media she moreover contends that this new form of visual communication fundamentally redefined relations between word and image poster designers embedded words within the graphic rather than using images to illustrate a text posters had to function as effective advertising in the hectic environment of the urban street even though initially commissioned as advertisements they were soon coveted by collectors iskin introduces readers to the late nineteenth century "iconophile" – a new type of collector curator archivist who discovered in poster collecting an ephemeral archaeology of modernity bridging the separation between the fields of art design advertising and collecting iskin's insightful study played a constitutive role in the modern culture of spectacle this stunningly illustrated book will appeal to art historians and students of visual culture as well as social and cultural history media design and advertising

this two volume set ccis 173 and ccis 174 constitutes the extended abstracts of the posters presented during the 14th international conference on human computer interaction hcii 2011 held in orlando fl usa in july 2011 jointly with 12 other thematically similar conferences a total of 4039 contributions was submitted to hcii 2011 of which 232 poster papers were carefully reviewed and selected for presentation as extended abstracts in the two volumes

in expressionism and poster design in germany 1905 1925 kathleen chapman re defines expressionism by situating it in relation to the most common type of picture in public space during the wilhelmine twentieth century the commercial poster focusing equally on visual material and contemporaneous debates surrounding art posters and the image in general this study reveals that conceptions of a modern image were characterized not so much by style or mode of production and distribution but by a visual rhetoric designed to communicate more directly than words as instances of such rhetoric expressionist art and posters emerge as equally significant examples of this modern image demonstrating the interconnectedness of the aesthetic the utilitarian and the commercial in european modernism

the six essays collected in this volume are a selection from a number of papers which were given at a one day colloquium on art literature and the spanish civil war which was held in westfield college on 18 july 1986 precisely fifty years to the day after franco s military coup in the canary islands which was destined to have such a decisive effect on the course of spanish history though this date subsequently became a francoist celebration the so called dia del alzamiento day of the uprising the papers collected here do not demonstrate a francoist bias the overall approach is intertextual and interdisciplinary thereby stressing the international nature of the artistic response to the war for the benefit of the english reader all foreign quotations are followed by an english translation

nominated for the 2017 dayton literary peace prize in non fiction this volume examines peace museums a small and important but often overlooked series of museums whose numbers have multiplied world wide in recent decades they relate stories and display artifacts banners diaries and posters for example about such themes as art and peace antiwar histories protest peacekeeping and social justice and promote cultures of peace this book introduces their different approaches from japan which has the largest number of sites to bradford uk and guernica spain some peace museums and centers emphasize popular peace symbols and figures others provide alternative narratives about conscientious objection or civil disobedience and still others are sites of persuasion challenging the status quo about issues of war peace disarmament and related issues introducing peace museums distinguishes between different types of museums that are linked to peace in name theme or purpose and discusses the debates which surround peace museums versus museums for peace this book is the first of its kind to critically evaluate the exhibits and activities of this group of museums and to consider the need for a critical peace museum studies which analyses their varied emphasis and content the work of an experienced specialist this welcome introduction to peace museums considers the challenges and opportunities faced by these institutions now and in the future

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
