when i look back at my incredibly lucky career as a writer it seems that there was never time to think it was as though i were skiing down a steep and hazardous mountain slope when i look back at the marks my skis made in the snow on the way down i only now realize that i wrote again and again about people who behaved decently in an indecent society from the foreword by kurt vonnegut at millennium's end looks back over the body of kurt vonnegut's writing examining the novels essays and short stories of one of the century's most beloved and widely read authors and social critics it also looks forward projecting vonnegut's relevance to the next millennium the essays by noted vonnegut scholars and personal friends are each written from the perspective of someone familiar with vonnegut's entire canon

kurt vonnegut is one of the most popular and admired authors of post war american literature famous both for his playful and deceptively simple style as well as for his scathing critiques of social injustice and war criti

american literature is profoundly almost inescapably political in this fascinating new anthology of original essays ten leading scholars explore the ways in which american civic education has been informally advanced through literature delving into the works of authors ranging from mark twain to william faulkner to octavia butler these essays reflect on the close relationship between democracy and literature

He recounts how celebrants at Nixon's state funeral, at which Bob Dole's eulogy depicted a God-fearing American hero, attempted to bury the sources of our divisions over him, rendering in some minds the judgment of redeemed statesman to erase his status as disgraced president. With dozens of illustrations, Nixon posing with Elvis, the National Archives' most requested photo, Nixonian cultural artifacts, classic editorial cartoons, no other book collects in one place such varied images of Nixon from so many diverse media. These reinforce Frick's probing analysis to help us understand why we disagree about Nixon and why it matters how we resolve our disagreements.
