

We Were Gonna Have A Baby But We Had An Angel Instead

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a lavish presentation of 208 folksongs collected throughout alabama in the 1940s alabama is a state rich in folksong tradition from old english ballads sung along the tennessee river to children s game songs played in mobile from the rhythmic work songs of the railroad gandy dancers of gadsden to the spirituals of the black belt the musical heritage of blacks and whites rich and poor hill folk and cotton farmers these songs endure as a living part of the state s varied past in the mid 1940s byron arnold an eager young music professor from the university of alabama set out to find and record as many of these songs as he could and was rewarded by unstinting cooperation from many informants mrs julia greer marechal of mobile for example was 90 years old blind and a semi invalid but she sang for arnold for three hours allowing the recording of 33 songs and exhausting arnold and his technician helped by such living repositories as mrs

marechal the arnold collection grew to well over 500 songs augmented by field notes and remarkable biographical information on the singers an alabama songbook is the result of arnold s efforts and those of his informants across the state and has been shaped by robert w halli jr into a narrative enriched by more than 200 significant songs lullabies civil war anthems african american gospel and secular songs fiddle tunes temperance songs love ballads play party rhymes and work songs in the tradition of alan lomax s the folk songs of north america and vance randolph s ozark folksongs this volume will appeal to general audiences folklorists ethnomusicologists preservationists traditional musicians and historians

does god want us to be wealthy many people believe that god offers not only eternal joy in the hereafter but also material blessings in the here and now other christians see this prosperity theology as nothing more than vulgar materialism incompatible with orthodox christianity in righteous riches milmon f harrison examines the word of faith movement an independent non denominational christian movement that preaches the so called health and wealth gospel the word of faith movement is an international network loosely bound by a basic doctrine called the faith message which teaches that it is god s will for christians to be prosperous successful and healthy in the present life drawing on his personal experiences as a former insider and in depth interviews with members harrison takes us inside the movement revealing what it is like to belong and how people accept reject and reshape word of faith doctrines to fit their own lives although the movement is not exclusively african american many of its most prominent and recognized leaders are african american ministers with large congregations and national television audiences analyzing the movement s appeal to african americans harrison argues that because of their history of oppression and discrimination african american religious institutions have always had to address the material as well as spiritual concerns of their members the word of faith movement he says is one of several prosperity movements that resonate strongly with african americans situating the movement in the contexts of both contemporary american religion and the history of the black church righteous riches offers a fascinating look at a quintessentially american phenomenon

over thirty years after his initial ascent to super stardom todd mcfarlane b 1961 remains one of the most popular and contentious comic artists ever the interviews compiled in this volume offer a nuanced portrait of mcfarlane s polarizing character beginning with his earliest days on spider man to the months before the hotly anticipated release of spawn and ending with his writing ventures decades later the interviews offer compelling perspectives from the renowned creator as the most vocal representative of image comics mcfarlane alongside jim lee rob liefeld erik larsen jim

valentino marc silvestri and wilce portacio was a veritable rock star eager fans swarmed into lengthy lines around comic book stores and conventions waiting for their chance at a thirty second autograph this book offers a glimpse into the comic book world of the early 1990s a world rampant with variant covers impossibly exaggerated bodies and wild speculation about what would be the next comic to explode in value the volume also includes the momentous public debate between mcfarlane and peter david former collaborator on the incredible hulk moderated by the late george p  rez at a standing room only event at comicsfest in 1993 while this world sounds almost inconceivable to the comic book fan of today it was the milieu in which mcfarlane rose to stardom and excelled like no other leaving his mark on the medium forever
