a coretta scott king author honor book this moving picture book portrays a girl who met injustice with dignity and excelled booklist starred review macnolia cox was no ordinary kid her idea of fun was reading the dictionary in 1936 eighth grader macnolia cox became the first african american to win the akron ohio spelling bee and with that win she was asked to compete at the prestigious national spelling bee in washington dc where she and a girl from new jersey were the first african americans invited since its founding she left her home state a celebrity right up there with ohio s own joe louis and jesse owens with a military band and a crowd of thousands to see her off at the station but celebration turned to chill when the train crossed the state line into maryland where segregation was the law of the land
