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hugo ball war einer der mitbegründer und wichtigsten figuren des deutschen dadaismus sein hier vorliegendes werk versteht sich als kritik des theologisch politischen systems und mächtigen versuch die freiheit des deutschen gedankens zu restituieren der verfasser verkündet eine renaissance des christentums außerhalb der staatlichen despotie ein evangelium der armen und entrechteten nach beseitigung des kastengeistes der volksfremden metaphysik und der

parteibevormundung der autor hat sein buch den führern der moralischen revolution gewidmet

dieses werk ist teil der buchreihe tredition classics der verlag tredition aus hamburg veröffentlicht in der buchreihe tredition classics werke aus mehr als zwei jahrtausenden diese waren zu einem großteil vergriffen oder nur noch antiquarisch erhältlich mit der buchreihe tredition classics verfolgt tredition das ziel tausende klassiker der weltliteratur verschiedener sprachen wieder als gedruckte bücher zu verlegen und das weltweit die buchreihe dient zur bewahrung der literatur und förderung der kultur sie trägt so dazu bei dass viele tausend werke nicht in vergessenheit geraten

hugo ball 1886 1927 war ein deutscher autor und biograf außerdem war er einer der mitgründer der dada bewegung und ein pionier des lautgedichts aus dem buch der päpstlich kaiserliche universalstaat des mittelalters leitete eine innige verbindung der deutschen völkerschaften mit dem zivilisiertesten lande der damaligen welt italien ein und wenn die gewaltsamen deutschen könige auch sobald sie den segen empfangen hatten nur richtschwert und vollstrecker des römischen willens geworden waren so verlieh ihnen diese weihe noch die kulturmission mehrer des kirchengebiets und verbreiter des evangeliums zu sein und damit jene heraldische attitüde einer von reichstrompetern begleiteten theologischen majestät der die buntbäurische phantasie des deutschen volkes noch heute nicht gewachsen ist

deutsche ideen deutscher geist und deutsche ideologien haben das weltgeschehen maßgeblich beeinflusst und geprägt peter watson zeichnet diese entwicklung von der mitte des 18 jahr hunderts bis zur gegenwart nach und ergründet ursprung und wesen des deutschen genius philosophie und literatur musik und malerei wissenschaft und technik watson bietet eine beeindruckende gesamtschau deutschen geisteslebens von lessing bis mann von humboldt bis benz von kant bis habermas von schleiermacher bis ratzinger von bach bis henze von friedrich bis beuys eine faszinierende kultur und ideengeschichte

der hugo ball der den dadaismus in jenem kurzen halben jahr 1916 im cabaret voltaire in zürich erfand ist weithin bekannt weniger bekannt ist ball als redakteur der wichtigsten zeitung des deutschsprachigen exils in der schweiz während des ersten weltkrieges die freie zeitung in bern an der er von 1917 bis 1919 mitwirkte wurde zum wichtigsten sprachrohr deutscher exilanten in dem die kriegspolitik hindenburgs und ludendorffs auf schärfste angegriffen wurde ball faßte 1919 seine Überlegungen in dem großen essay zur kritik der deutschen intelligenz zusammen der im verlag der freien zeitung erschien eine art abrechnung mit der deutschen ideologie von luther bis bismarck von hegel bis marx an die stelle der offiziellen heroen deutscher geschichte setzt ball als alternative eine ahnenreihe von großen religiösen und moralisten auch seine jahrelange beschäftigung mit dem russischen anarchistin bakunin findet hier ihren niederschlag im rahmen der hugo ball ausgabe wird nicht nur erstmals wieder der ungekürzte text der erstausgabe von 1919 vorgelegt der band enthält auch die unter dem titel die folgen der reformation

in this work david c durst explores the development of modernism in the philosophy politics and culture of the first german republic between 1918 and 1933

through a reasoned critique of various weimar intellectual figures such as ernst bloch martin heidegger and theodor adorno durst offers clarity and insight into the various aesthetic postures of the interwar period from the cultural vibrancy of the early weimar period to the eventual decay towards fascism and nazi rule weimar modernism provides a new and coherent way to examine this important era which has often been presented in a fragmented manner

designed to provide english readers of german literature the opportunity to familiarize themselves with both the established canon and newly emerging literatures that reflect the concerns of women and ethnic minorities the encyclopedia of german literature includes more than 500 entries on writers individual work and topics essential to an understanding of this rich literary tradition drawing on the expertise of an international group of experts the essays in the encyclopedia reflect developments of the latest scholarship in german literature culture and history and society in addition to the essays author entries include biographies and works lists and works entries provide information about first editions selected critical editions and english language translations all entries conclude with a list of further readings

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
