the first world war which began in 1914 july 28 1914 divided ukrainian territories between the russian and austro hungarian empires during this time a political movement called the union for the liberation of ukraine was initiated by a six member administrative team that gathered on august 4 1914 with the aim of ukraine s liberation the names of these six individuals were volodymyr doroshenko marian melenevsky andrii zhuk mykola zalizniak oleksander skoropys yoltukhovsky and dmytro dontsov based in vienna the union for the liberation of ukraine made various publications to raise awareness in european public opinion and appealed for military support as well while they particularly sought to gain the attention of germany states reluctant to antagonize russia provided financial support albeit reluctantly the society s headquarters in vienna were later moved to berlin they also had offices in places like switzerland and romania and
