quality criteria and ethical considerations were applied the findings show that trlrs are firmly based on relationship qualities strong feelings common actions spirituality and future orientation further the findings present clear interlinkages between trlr and soc contributing positively to meaningfulness manageability and comprehensibility finally trlrs support soc on intrapersonal cultural and interpersonal levels in addition they influence the development of identity awareness actions feelings and sexual soc conclusions limitations and recommendations for theory and practice are provided
