In the first half, the author presents a woodworking history primarily in Europe and the United States that highlights the practical and philosophical issues that have marked women's participation in the field. Research focuses on a diverse range of practitioners from Lady Yun to Adina White. This is followed by sixteen in-depth profiles of contemporary woodworkers, all of whom identify fine woodworking as their principal vocation. Through studio visits, interviews, and photographs of space and process, the book uncovers the varied practices and contributions these diverse artisans make to the understanding of wood as a medium to engage spatial, material, aesthetic, and even existential challenges. Beautifully illustrated profiles include Wendy Maruyama, one of the first women to earn an MFA in woodworking in the US; Sarah Marriage, founder of Baltimore's A Workshop of Our Own, a woodshop and educational space specifically for women and gender non-conforming makers; Yuri Kobayashi, whose sublime work blurs boundaries between the worlds of art and craft, sculpture and furniture; and Folayemi Wilson, whose work draws equally on African American history and Afrofuturism to explore and illuminate the ways that furniture and wood traditions shape social relations.

the long history of the racial wealth gap in america told through the stories of seven black families who struggled to build wealth over multiple generations wealth is central to the american pursuit of happiness and is an overriding measure of well being yet wealth is conspicuously absent from african american households why do some 3 5 million black american families have zero or negative wealth historian calvin schermerhorn traces four hundred years of black dispossession and decapitalization what frederick douglass called plunder through the stories of families who have strived to earn and keep the fruits of their toils their struggles reveal that the ever evolving strategies to strip black income and wealth have been critical to sustaining a structure of racialized disadvantage these accounts also tell of the quiet heroism of those who worked to overcome obstacles and defy the plunder from the story of anthony and mary johnson abducted from angola and brought to virginia in 1619 to the enslaved black workers dispossessed by the custis washington family to venture smith born broteer furro who purchased his freedom to three generations of a family enslaved in the

south who moved north after emancipation to the tulsa massacre and the subprime lending crisis schermerhorn shows that we cannot reckon with today's racial wealth inequality without understanding its unrelenting role in american history

william haldane opened a cabinet shop in 1836 14 years before grand rapids incorporated other furniture companies followed berkey and gay widdicomb sligh hekman and phoenix were among those taking advantage of the grand river for transportation and power the area's abundant hardwood supply and a growing immigrant labor pool the furniture soon attracted national attention in 1876 the philadelphia centennial exposition proved conclusively that a river town in michigan had indeed earned the title furniture city presidents herbert hoover franklin d roosevelt harry s truman and dwight d eisenhower all worked at grand rapids made desks fifteen manufacturers joined forces to build 1 000 handley page bombers during world war i the japanese instrument of surrender was signed on september 2 1945 at a table made in grand rapids despite fires floods strikes depressions and wars grand rapids led the industry until the 1950s and 1960s when the factories began moving to north carolina today the area along with nearby holland and zeeland dominates the office furniture industry
