langston hughes was one of the most important american writers of his generation and one of the most versatile producing poetry fiction drama and autobiography in this innovative study r baxter miller explores hughes s life and art to enlarge our appreciation of his contribution to american letters arguing that readers often miss the complexity of hughes s work because of its seeming accessibility miller begins with a discussion of the writer s auto biography an important yet hitherto neglected key to his imagination moving on to consider the subtle resonances of his life in the varied genres over which his imagination wandered miller finds a constant symbiotic bond between the historical and the lyrical the range of hughes s artistic vision is revealed in his depiction of black women his political stance his lyric and tragi comic modes this is one of the first studies to apply recent methods of literary analysis including formalist structuralist and semiotic criticism to the work of a black american writer miller not only affirms in hughes s work the peculiar qualities of black american culture but provides a unifying conception of his art and identifies the primary metaphors lying at its heart here is a fresh and coherent reading of the work of one of the twentieth century s greatest voices a reinterpretation that renews our appreciation not only of black american text and heritage but of the literary imagination itself

use your imagination the demand is as important as it is confusing what is the imagination what is its value where does it come from and where is it going in a time when even the obscene m seems overdone and passé this book takes up these questions and argues for the centrality of imagination in human cognition it traces the development of the imagination in kant s critical philosophy particularly the critique of aesthetic judgment and claims that the insights of kantian aesthetic theory especially concerning the nature of creativity common sense and genius influenced the development of nineteenth century american philosophy the book identifies the central role of the imagination in the philosophy of peirce a role often overlooked in analytic treatments of his thought the final

chapters pursue the observation made by kant and peirce that imaginative genius is a type of natural gift ingenium and must in some way be continuous with the creative force of nature it makes this final turn by way of contemporary studies of metaphor embodied cognition and cognitive neuroscience

the relatively recent worship wars over styles of worship traditional contemporary or blended have calmed down and many churches have now reached decisions about which worship style defines them at a more fundamental level however change has yet to begin in from memory to imagination randall bradley argues that fallout from the worship wars needs to be cleaned up and that fundamental cultural changes namely the effects of postmodernism call for new approaches to worship outlining imaginative ways for the church to move forward this book is a must read for church leaders and anyone interested in worship music

a classic text in biblical theology still relevant for today and tomorrow in this 40th anniversary edition of the classic text from one of the most influential biblical scholars of our time walter brueggemann offers a theological and ethical reading of the hebrew bible he finds there a vision for the community of god whose words and practices of lament protest and complain give rise to an alternative social order that opposes the totalism of the day brueggemann traces the lines from the radical vision of moses to the solidification of royal power in solomon to the prophetic critique of that power with a new vision of freedom in the prophets linking exodus to kings to jeremiah to jesus he argues that the prophetic vision not only embraces the pain of the people but creates an energy and amazement based on the new thing that god is doing this edition builds off the revised and updated 2001 edition and includes a new afterword by brueggemann and a new foreword by davis hankins

refiguring the sacred conversations with paul ricoeur offers perspectives on the twenty one papers collected by mark i wallace in paul ricoeur s figuring the sacred translated by david pellauer this new collection by joseph a edelheit james moore and mark i wallace gives ricoeur scholars an opportunity to reflect and engage on critical issues of ricoeur s religious ideas contributions by several significant ricoeur scholars prompt questions and invite new conversations more than 15 years after ricoeur s death his life long engagement with texts illuminates his embrace of the sacred his significant thinking and writings on religious imagination theology the bible hope and praxis are all ideas that beg more reading reflection and refiguring of our understanding of ricoeur wallace brings two additional essays that could not be included in his original collection and reflects on why they are essential to our understanding of ricoeur and the sacred refiguring the sacred also provides a model of the interfaith and multidisciplinary dialogue that were foundational to paul ricoeur s scholarship

bernadette höfer s innovative and ambitious monograph argues that the epistemology of the cartesian mind body dualism and its insistence on the primacy of analytic thought over bodily function has surprisingly little purchase in texts by prominent classical writers in this study höfer explores how surin molière lafayette and racine represent interconnections of body and mind that influence behaviour both voluntary and involuntary and that thus disprove the classical notion of the mind as distinct from and superior to the body the author s interdisciplinary perspective utilizes early modern medical and philosophical treatises as well as contemporary medical compilations in the disciplines of psychosomatic medicine neurobiology and psychoanalysis to demonstrate that these seventeenth century french writers established a view of human existence that fully anticipates current thought regarding psychosomatic illness

when he was a student at oxford university c s lewis wrote to a friend expressing his great admiration of and enthusiasm for the novels of nathaniel hawthorne particularly the house of the seven gables and transformation british title of the marble faun this study examines the parallels between these two kindred spirits and their works focusing on their similar worldviews their personal backgrounds and lifestyles and the ultimates they both pondered it discusses common themes in their works such as myth scientism and the great power of blackness their respective attitudes toward these issues and others such as faith repentance heaven and hell confession church attendance the clergy and puritanism are strikingly similar considerable attention is given to companion pieces of the two writers with discussion of the so called fortunate fall in the marble faun and perelandra veil imagery in the minister s black veil the blithedale romance and till we have faces influence of bunyan s allegory on the pilgrim s regress and the celestial railroad and multiform love in the four loves and the house of the seven gables examination of such affinities between these two writers and their works provides mutual illumination and enhanced appreciation of each

imagination is an outstanding contribution to a notoriously elusive and confusing subject it skillfully interrelates problems in philosophy the history of ideas and literary theory and criticism tracing the evolution of the concept of imagination from hume and kant in the eighteenth century to ryle sartre and wittgenstein in the twentieth she strongly believes that the cultivation of imagination should be the chief aim of education and one of her objectives in writing the book has been to put forward reasons why this is so purely philosophical treatment of the concept is shown to be related to its use in the work of

coleridge and wordsworth who she considers to be the creators of a new kind of awareness with more than literary implications the purpose of her historical account is to suggest that the role of imagination in our perception and thought is more pervasive than may at first sight appear and that the thread she traces is an important link joining apparently different areas of our experience she argues that imagination is an essential element in both our awareness of the world and our attaching of value to it

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
