this study investigates the various extreme rightist leagues in algeria with particular attention to certain key themes among them the rabid xenophobia directed at the jewish population and local muslims it demonstrates that fascism helped to construct a racial hierarchy to preserve european hegemony and a pool of cheap labor

this book explores the political construction of imperial frontiers during the reigns of ferdinand the catholic and charles v in the iberian peninsula and the mediterranean contrary to many studies on this topic this book neither focuses on a specific frontier nor attempts to provide an overview of all the imperial frontiers instead it focuses on a specific individual juan rena 1480 1539 this venetian clergyman spent 40 years serving the king in several capacities while travelling from the maghreb to northern spain from the pyrenees to the western fringes of the ottoman empire by focusing on his activities the book offers an account of the spanish empire s frontiers as a vibrant political space where a multiplicity of figures interacted to shape power relations from below furthermore it describes how merchants military officers nobles local elites and royal agents forged a specific political culture in the empire s liminal spaces through their negotiations and cooperation but also through their competition and clashes they created practices and norms in areas like cross cultural diplomacy the making of the social fabric the definition of new jurisdictions and the mobilization of resources for war

similarities between esoteric and mystical currents in different religious traditions have long interested scholars this book takes a new look at the relationship between such currents it advances a discussion that started with the search for religious essences

archetypes and universals from william james to eranos the universal categories that resulted from that search were later criticized as essentialist constructions and questioned by deconstructionists an alternative explanation was advanced by diffusionists that there were transfers between different traditions this book presents empirical case studies of such constructions and of transfers between judaism christianity and islam in the premodern period and judaism christianity and western esotericism in the modern period it shows that there were indeed transfers that can be clearly documented and that there were also indeed constructions often very imaginative it also shows that there were many cases that were neither transfers nor constructions but a mixture of the two

the surprising story of the wine industry s role in the rise of french algeria and the fall of empire we owe to wine a blessing far more precious than gold the peopling of algeria with frenchmen stated agriculturist pierre berthault in the early 1930s in the last decades of the nineteenth century europeans had displaced algerians from the colony s best agricultural land and planted grapevines soon enough wine was the primary export of a region whose mostly muslim inhabitants didn t drink alcohol settlers made fortunes while drawing large numbers of algerians into salaried work for the first time but the success of algerian wine resulted in friction with french producers challenging the traditional view that imperial possessions should complement not compete with the metropole by the middle of the twentieth century amid the fight for independence algerians had come to see the rows of vines as an especially hated symbol of french domination after the war algerians had to decide how far they would go to undo the transformations the colonists had wrought including the world s fourth biggest wine industry owen white examines algeria s experiment with nationalized wine production in worker run vineyards the pressures that resulted in the failure of that experiment and the eventual uprooting of most of the country s vines with a special focus on individual experiences of empire from the wealthiest europeans to the poorest laborers in the fields the blood of the colony shows the central role of wine in the economic life of french algeria and in its settler culture white makes clear that the industry left a long term mark on the development of the nation

a revelatory account of a spiritual leader who dared to assert the value of rabbinic doubt in the face of messianic certainty in 1665 sabbetai zevi a self proclaimed messiah with a mass following throughout the ottoman empire and europe announced that the redemption of the world was at hand as jews everywhere rejected the traditional laws of judaism in favor of new norms established by sabbetai zevi and abandoned reason for the ecstasy of messianic enthusiasm one man watched in horror dissident rabbi tells the story of jacob sasportas the sephardic rabbi who alone challenged sabbetai

zevi's improbable claims and warned his fellow jews that their messiah was not the answer to their prayers yaacob dweck's absorbing and richly detailed biography brings to life the tumultuous century in which sasportas lived an age torn apart by war migration and famine he describes the messianic frenzy that gripped the jewish diaspora and sasportas's attempts to make sense of a world that sabbetai zevi claimed was ending as jews danced in the streets sasportas compiled the fading flower of the zevi a meticulous and eloquent record of sabbatianism as it happened in 1666 barely a year after sabbetai zevi heralded the redemption the messiah converted to islam at the behest of the ottoman sultan and sasportas's book slipped into obscurity dissident rabbi is the revelatory account of a spiritual leader who dared to articulate the value of rabbinic doubt in the face of messianic certainty and a revealing examination of how his life and legacy were rediscovered and appropriated by later generations of jewish thinkers
