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this title is directed primarily towards health care professionals outside of the united states it takes a comprehensive look at the issues surrounding mental illness and pregnancy describing common disorders and their relationship with pregnancy it promotes an understanding of the issues involved and offers tools to providing the most effective woman centred maternity care all health professionals concerned with the wellbeing of the pregnant woman will find invaluable help and guidance in this book given the identification of mental health problems as a leading cause of maternal death cemd 2001 this is an essential guide to the effects of pregnancy and childbirth on women and families coping with mental illness

a panel of top experts in perinatal psychiatry reviews the many recent studies on the use of psychiatric medications in pregnancy and postpartum and assesses their impact on the diagnosis and treatment of pregnant postpartum women the authors focus on each of the major psychiatric illnesses including depression anxiety disorder bipolar disorder schizophrenia substance abuse eating disorders and mental illness as well as on the potential impact of these illnesses on infants and children interpreting conflicting and inconclusive clinical findings they spell out the lesser known risks of prenatal medication exposure and

illuminate a variety of issues that must be taken into account in choosing such treatments as medications psychotherapy parental education and social skills training

clues which point toward the etiology of postpartum psychiatric illness and its appropriate treatment are spread over four continents and 150 years of history james alexander hamilton and patricia neel harberger decided that it was time to assemble the bits and pieces of information postpartum psychiatric illness a picture puzzle is an exceptional work that presents a wealth of research and treatment considerations in this neglected field

child and adolescent psychiatry hosts a range of diverse epistemological positions regarding the origin of psychical suffering from fully endogenous e g genetic to mostly exogenous e g family trauma etc the complexity of clinical situations generally precludes such epistemologies to require exclusive therapeutic strategies psychodynamic psychotherapy can be fruitful in the context of monogenic genetic illnesses at the family or individual level while pharmacology can be a necessary tool in a variety of difficult relational contexts or personality issues e g in adolescence thus nowadays the most promising therapeutic perspectives in child and adolescent psychiatry attempt to do justice to the polyfactorial complexity of mental suffering notably by refining their psychopathologies by drawing on e g biopsychosocial or epigenetic models even more so as prevention policies ask for longitudinal studies to help with the early detection of potential future troubles

due to their prevalence pervasiveness and burden inflicted on men and women of today psychiatric disorders are considered as one of the most important severe and painful illnesses this impairment of cognitive emotional or behavioural functioning is in some cases tragic aside from knowing the physical organic factors such as infections endocrinal illnesses or head injuries the aetiology of psychiatric disorders has remained a mystery however recent advances in psychiatry and neuroscience have been successful in discovering subsequent pathophysiology and reaching associated bio psycho social factors this book consists of recent trends and developments in psychiatry from all over the world presented in the form of multifarious and comprehensive articles the first two sections of the book are reserved for articles on schizophrenia and depression two major illnesses present in this field the third section of the book is reserved for addiction psychiatry related not only to socio cultural but also biological alterations the last section of the book titled biological neuropsychiatry consists of three topics updated molecular biology fundamental neuroscience and clinical neuropsychiatric conditions doubtlessly this book will be fruitful for future developments and collaboration in world psychiatry

composed of two types of scientific events those structured by the association and those left to the initiative of the participants the first type comprised plenary sessions planned by the scientific program committee and section symposia organized by the wpa sections the second embraced free symposia free papers video sessions and poster presentations prepared by the participants altogether 10 plenary sessions 52 section symposia and 105 free symposia took place and 78 free papers and poster sessions and 10 video sessions were held

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
