the sonderkommando the special squad of enslaved jewish laborers who were forced to work in the gas chambers and crematoria of auschwitz birkenau comprise one of the most fascinating and troubling topics within holocaust history as eyewitnesses to and unwilling abettors of the murder of their fellow jews they are the object of fierce condemnation even today yet it was a group of these seemingly compromised men who carried out the revolt of october 7 1944 one of the most celebrated acts of holocaust resistance this interdisciplinary collection assembles careful investigations into how the sonderkommando have been represented by themselves and by others both during and after the holocaust

hermann langbein was allowed to know and see extraordinary things forbidden to other auschwitz inmates interned at auschwitz in 1942 and classified as a non jewish political prisoner he was assigned as clerk to the chief ss physician of the extermination camp complex which gave him access to documents conversations and actions that would have remained unknown to history were it not for his witness and his subsequent research also a member of the auschwitz resistance langbein sometimes found himself in a position to influence events though at his peril people in auschwitz is very different from other works on the most infamous of nazi annihilation centers langbein s account is a scrupulously scholarly achievement intertwining his own experiences with quotations from other inmates ss guards and administrators civilian industry and military personnel and official documents whether his recounting deals with captors or inmates langbein analyzes the events and their context objectively in an unemotional style rendering a narrative that is unique in the history of the holocaust this monumental book helps us comprehend what has so tenaciously challenged understanding

this is the first hand account of rudolf s vrba s extraordinary experiences as a registrar at auschwitz as well as the story of his daring escape although a testimonial full of unbearable vivid horror and suffering it isn t this that makes the book so gripping and so important what endures is vrba s personality his unbelievable physical tenacity and incredibly enough his sense of humour vrba was imprisoned in auschwitz for twenty one months and seven days he then escaped with his fellow

slovak alfred weltzler as they made their way home they carried with them seared in their immediate memory the true story of the camp the hitherto unknown destination of jewish deportees from all over europe initially conceived as a serialisation in the daily herald in 1960 this full account is being published for the first time in twenty years it is a must read for any person interested in understanding not only the inner workings of the prison camp with the expected horrors and brutality but also a personal story of strength survival and guile

a large number of all the orders ever issued by the various commanders of the infamous auschwitz camp have been preserved they reveal the true nature of the camp with all its daily events in these orders for example the decent treatment of inmates the prohibition of their mistreatment as well as the improvement of the hygienic conditions were emphasized a topic discussed with particular frequency is the visit of family members of ss members to auschwitz and their constant entering and exiting of the camp even the children of ss members were hanging around in the camp and were apparently playing with the inmates there were even plenty of sightseeing tours of the camp during the war which some orders tried to regulate horticulture growing fruit trees picking flowers and much more were addressed in these orders only one thing is not to be found in these orders the slightest trace of an indication that something outrageous was going on at auschwitz on the contrary many orders are in clear and insurmountable contradiction to claims that inmates were being mass murdered this book contains a selection of the most important of these orders along with comments that put them in their proper historical context

a history of the holocaust is a detailed factual account of what happened across europe during the holocaust with balanced coverage of each country the holocaust was unique within the context of the second world war because jews were disproportionately represented among the civilian casualties in that conflict over fifty million people died as a result of the application of total war

a shocking account of nazi genocide and the inhuman conditions in auschwitz but equally shocking is the initial disbelief with which the revelations were met alfred wetzler was a true hero his escape from auschwitz and the report he helped compile telling for the first time the truth about the camp as a place of mass murder led directly to saving the lives of 120 000 jews no other single act in the second world war saved so many jews from the fate that hitler and the ss had determined for them sir martin gilbert together with another young slovak jew rudolf vrba both deported in 1942 the author succeeded in escaping from the notorious death camp in the spring of 1944 there were some very few successful escapes from auschwitz during the war but it was these two who smuggled out the damning evidence a ground plan of the camp constructional details of the gas chambers and crematoriums and most convincingly a label from a canister of cyclone gas the book is cast in the form of a novel to allow information not personally collected by the two fugitives but provided for them by a handful of reliable friends to be included nothing however has been invented from the
