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like music art is a universal language although looking at works of art is a pleasurable enough experience to appreciate them fully requires certain skills and knowledge carol strickland from the introduction to the annotated mona lisa a crash course in art history from prehistoric to post modern this heavily illustrated crash course in art history is revised and updated this second edition of carol strickland s the annotated mona lisa a crash course in art history from prehistoric to post modern offers an illustrated tutorial of prehistoric to post modern art from cave paintings to video art installations to digital and internet media featuring succinct page length essays instructive sidebars and more than 300 photographs the annotated mona lisa a crash course in art history from prehistoric to post modern takes art history out of the realm of dreary textbooks demystifies jargon and theory and makes art accessible even at a cursory reading from stonehenge to the guggenheim and from holbein to warhol more than 25 000 years of art is distilled into five sections covering a little more than 200 pages

presents the history of art from prehistoric times to the present day describes major artists and movements and details the influence of art on society through the ages

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contains biographical information on the renaissance and baroque nineteenth century and twentieth century artists also includes extension activities following each biography

designed to provide instruction that builds literacy skills by accomodating and supporting the reading needs and abilities of each student
