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global events of the early twenty first century have placed new stress on the relationship among anthropology governance and war facing prolonged insurgency segments of the u s military have taken a new interest in anthropology prompting intense ethical and scholarly debate inspired by these issues the essays in anthropology and global counterinsurgency consider how anthropologists can should and do respond to military overtures and they articulate anthropological perspectives on global war and power relations this book investigates the shifting boundaries between military and civil state violence perceptions and effects of american power around the globe the history of counterinsurgency doctrine and practice and debate over culture knowledge and conscience in counterinsurgency these wide ranging essays shed new light on the fraught world of pax americana and on the ethical and political dilemmas faced by anthropologists and military personnel alike when attempting to understand and intervene in

our world

since september 2001 the united states has waged what the government initially called the global war on terrorism gwot beginning in late 2005 and early 2006 the term long war began to appear in u s security documents such as the national security council s national strategy for victory in iraq and in statements by the u s secretary of defense and the chairman of the jcs the description long war unlimited in time and space and continuing for decades is closer to reality and more useful than gwot colonel robert cassidy argues that this protracted struggle is more correctly viewed as a global insurgency and counterinsurgency al qaeda and its affiliates he maintains comprise a novel and evolving form of networked insurgents who operate globally harnessing the advantages of globalization and the information age they employ terrorism as a tactic subsuming terror within their overarching aim of undermining the western dominated system of states placing the war against al qaeda and its allied groups and organizations in the context of a global insurgency has vital implications for doctrine interagency coordination and military cultural change all reviewed in this important work cassidy combines the foremost maxims of the most prominent western philosopher of war and the most renowned eastern philosopher of war to arrive at a threefold theme know the enemy know yourself and know what kind of war you are embarking upon to help readers arrive at that understanding he first offers a distilled analysis of al qaeda and its associated networks with a particular focus on ideology and culture in subsequent chapters he elucidates the challenges big powers face when they prosecute counterinsurgencies using historical examples from russian american british and french counterinsurgent wars before 2001 the book concludes with recommendations for the integration and command and control of indigenous forces and other agencies

this book analyses the nationalist rebellion which emerged in romania following the second world war the first two decades after the end of the war were times of rebellion in imperial peripheries armed movements sometimes communist but nearly always nationalist in orientation rose in opposition to retreating or advancing imperial powers one such armed revolt took place in romania pitting nationalist partisans against a communist government this book is an analysis of how the authorities crushed this rebellion set in the context of parallel campaigns fought in europe and the third world it focuses on population control through censorship propaganda and deportations it analyses military operations particularly patrols checkpoints ambushes and informed strikes intelligence operations are also discussed with an emphasis on recruiting informants on interrogation torture and infiltration bullets brains and barbwire not hearts and minds approaches crushed internal rebels in post 1945 campaigns

relocation as a strategy and operational approach in war has reappeared in various forms from the late 18th century to the present day in a global history of relocation in counterinsurgency warfare edward j erickson brings together a distinguished cast of contributors to present a chronological survey of the major relocations of people conducted as deliberate operational approaches to modern conflicts each chapter covers a different case study including the removal of native americans in the usa la reconcentracion in cuba the american internment of filipinos after the balangiga massacre the deportation of the boer population in south africa and the relocation of ottoman armenians and russian jews bringing together the threads of the separate case studies the conclusion reaffirms relocation as a deliberate operational approach

used by major powers in warfare against real or perceived threats this is a vital volume for academics and students interested in military history counterinsurgency and strategic studies

a collection of original works covering all aspects of insurgency and counterinsurgency through a multinational lens insurgency and counterinsurgency in modern war addresses the need to look beyond the united states and other prominent counterinsurgency actors in the contemporary world it also reassesses some of the latent and burgeoning insurgen

the counterinsurgency coin paradigm dominates military and political conduct in contemporary western strategic thought it assumes future wars will unfold as low intensity conflicts within rather than between states requiring specialized military training and techniques coin is understood as a logical effective and democratically palatable method for confronting insurgency a discrete set of practices that through the actions of knowledgeable soldiers and under the guidance of an expert elite creates lasting results through an extensive investigation into coin s theories methods and outcomes this book undermines enduring claims about coin s success while revealing its hidden meanings and effects interrogating the relationship between counterinsurgency and war the authors question the supposed uniqueness of coin s attributes and try to resolve the puzzle of its intellectual identity is coin a strategy a doctrine a theory a military practice or something else their analysis ultimately exposes a critical paradox within coin while it ignores the vital political dimensions of war it is nevertheless the product of a misplaced ideological faith in modernization

the strategic use of force in counterinsurgency find fix fight focuses on how to understand the relationship between the use of force and the outcomes of such use specifically there is debate as to how to evaluate counterinsurgency conflicts and what prescriptions flow from that evaluation the neo classicist school emphasises prescriptions which are either directly from or inspired by cold war counterinsurgency efforts undertaken by anti communist states the revisionist school focuses on how best to evaluate the political dimensions of such conflicts this book finds that a third approach reflective action is best as it combines neo classicism s strength of issuing practical prescriptions with revisionism s strength for conceptually evaluating counterinsurgency conflicts this conceptual debate is expositied in three cases they are the british counterinsurgency during the malayan emergency of the 1940s and 1950s american counterinsurgency in south vietnam during the 1960s and 1970s and the coalition counterinsurgency in iraq during the 2000s

this two volume history of counterinsurgency covers all the major and many of the lesser known examples of this widespread and enduring form of conflict addressing the various measures employed in the attempt to overcome the insurgency and examining the individuals and organizations responsible for everything from counterterrorism to infrastructure building how and when should counterinsurgency be pursued as insurgency is growing in frequency and conversely while conventional warfare continues to decline as a means by which political rivals seek to impose their will upon each other what lessons from the past should today s policymakers strategists military leaders

and soldiers in the field keep in mind while facing off against 21st century insurgents this two volume set offers a comprehensive history of modern counterinsurgency covering the key examples of this widespread and enduring form of conflict it identifies the political military social and economic measures employed in attempting to overcome insurgency examining the work of the individuals and organizations involved demonstrating how success and failure dictated change from established policy and carefully analyzing the results readers will gain valuable insight from the detailed assessments of the history of counterinsurgency that demonstrate which strategies have succeeded and which have failed and why after an introductory essay on the subject each chapter provides historical background to the insurgency being addressed before focusing on the specific policies pursued and actions taken by the counterinsurgency force each section also provides an assessment of those operations including in most cases an analysis of lessons learned and where appropriate their relevance to counterinsurgency operations today the set s coverage spans modern counterinsurgencies from europe to asia to africa since 1900 and includes the ongoing counterinsurgency operations in afghanistan today its wide international approach to the subject makes the set a prime resource for readers seeking specific information on a particular conflict or a better understanding of the general theories and practices of counterinsurgency

this book maps the increasing convergence of us domestic and international security regimes analyzing the trend towards global pacification in the name of security the dream of liberal world peace after the cold war is on the verge of collapsing into permanent global pacification not only in the global south but also in pockets of the third world within the territory of western states in this volume the author explores the ways in which regimes of security have been extended into increasingly large aspects of social life and shows that their expansion has been driven by a constant broadening of the notion of war filling a gap in the literature the book demonstrates how us security agencies have sought to develop indeterminate security capabilities aimed at distinguishing between legitimate and illegitimate flows of people and resources this analysis of regimes of security is tied to a more general discussion about the persistence or even multiplication of illiberal forms of power within liberal governmentality this book will be of much interest to students of security studies war and conflict studies and international relations in general

the notion of counter insurgency has become a dominant paradigm in american and british thinking about the wars in iraq and afghanistan this volume brings together international academics and practitioners to evaluate the broader theoretical and historical factors that underpin coin providing a critical reappraisal of counter insurgency thinking

since the surge in iraq in 2006 counterinsurgency effectively became america s dominant approach for fighting wars yet many of the major controversies and debates surrounding counterinsurgency have turned not on military questions but on legal ones who can the military attack with drones is the occupation of iraq legitimate what tradeoffs should the military make between self protection and civilian casualties what is the right framework for negotiating with the taliban how can we build the rule of law in afghanistan the counterinsurgent s constitution tackles this wide range of legal issues from the vantage point of counterinsurgency strategy ganesh sitaraman

explains why law matters in counterinsurgency how it operates on the ground and how law and counterinsurgency strategy can be better integrated counterinsurgency sitaraman notes focuses on winning over the population providing essential services building political and legal institutions and fostering economic development so unlike in conventional war where law places humanitarian restraints on combat law and counterinsurgency are well aligned and reinforce one another indeed following the law and building the rule of law is not just the right thing to do it is strategically beneficial moreover reconciliation with enemies can both help to end the conflict and preserve the possibility of justice for war crimes following the rule of law is an important element of success the first book on law and counterinsurgency strategy the counterinsurgent s constitution seamlessly integrates law and military strategy to illuminate some of the most pressing issues in warfare and the transition from war to peace its lessons also apply to conflicts in libya and other hot spots in the middle east

david kilcullen is one of the world s most influential experts on counterinsurgency and modern warfare a ground breaking theorist whose ideas are revolutionizing military thinking throughout the west washington post indeed his vision of modern warfare powerfully influenced the united states decision to rethink its military strategy in iraq and implement the surge now recognized as a dramatic success in counterinsurgency kilcullen brings together his most salient writings on this vitally important topic here is a picture of modern warfare by someone who has had his boots on the ground in some of today s worst trouble spots including iraq and afghanistan and who has been studying counterinsurgency since 1985 filled with down to earth common sense insights this book is the definitive account of counterinsurgency indispensable for all those interested in making sense of our world in an age of terror

counterinsurgency the violent suppression of armed insurrection is among the dominant kinds of war in contemporary world politics often linked to protecting populations and reconstructing legitimate political orders it has appeared in other times and places in very different forms and has taken on a range of politics in doing so how did it arrive at its present form and what generated these others along the way spanning several centuries and four detailed case studies the counterinsurgent imagination unpacks and explores this intellectual history through counterinsurgency manuals these military theoretical and instructional texts and the practitioners who produced them made counterinsurgency possible in practice by interrogating these processes this book explains how counter insurrectionary war eventually took on its late twentieth and early twenty first century forms it shows how and why counterinsurgent ideas persist despite recurring failures

this book examines the various strategies including global counterinsurgency gcoin which have been put forward as alternatives to the global war on terror gwot concluding that while a consensus can be found on the key elements of a grand strategy based on failures in the gwot it is far from clear if any gcoin strategy could work

this timely and critical volume questions the effectiveness of britain s hearts and minds approach challenging conventional counterinsurgency thinking by drawing on the expertise of regional and thematic specialists

in varieties of sovereignty and citizenship scholars from a wide range of disciplines reflect on the transformation of the world away from the absolute sovereignty of independent nation states and on the proliferation of varieties of plural citizenship the emergence of possible new forms of allegiance and their effect on citizens and on political processes underlie the essays in this volume the essays reflect widespread acceptance that we cannot grasp either the empirical realities or the important normative issues today by focusing only on sovereign states and their actions interests and aspirations all the contributors accept that we need to take into account a great variety of globalizing forces but they draw very different conclusions about those realities for some the challenges to the sovereignty of nation states are on the whole to be regretted and resisted these transformations are seen as endangering both state capacity and state willingness to promote stability and security internationally moreover they worry that declining senses of national solidarity may lead to cutbacks in the social support systems many states provide to all those who reside legally within their national borders others view the system of sovereign nation states as the aspiration of a particular historical epoch that always involved substantial problems and that is now appropriately giving way to new more globally beneficial forms of political association some contributors to this volume display little sympathy for the claims on behalf of sovereign states though they are just as wary of emerging forms of cosmopolitanism which may perpetuate older practices of economic exploitation displacement of indigenous communities and military technologies of domination collectively the contributors to this volume require us to rethink deeply entrenched assumptions about what varieties of sovereignty and citizenship are politically possible and desirable today and they provide illuminating insights into the alternative directions we might choose to pursue

language is never just a means of communication it terrorizes and especially in times of war it has the ability to target civilians and generate fear as a means of producing specific political outcomes most notably the passive and active acceptance of state violence itself for this reason the critical examination of language must be a central part of any effort to fight imperialism militarism demagoguery racism sexism and other structures of injustice globalizing collateral language examines the discourse surrounding 9 11 and its entrenchment in global politics and culture to interrogate this wartime lexicon of collateral language editors john collins and somdeep sen have assembled a volume of critical essays that explores the long shadow of america s war on terror discourse they illuminate how this language has now found resonance across the globe and in political projects that have little to do with the war on terror two decades after the attacks of september 11 2001 this book calls on us to resist the tyranny of collateral language at a time when the need for such interventions in the public sphere is more urgent than ever

this volume addresses essential themes in international relations today asking how we can establish when religious identity is a relevant factor in politics when and how religion can be applied to advance positive peace oriented agendas in global governance and how governments can reconsider their foreign and domestic policies

to avoid the footpaths which may have been mined with improvised explosive devices ieds ryan evans a u s federal civilian was walking across a wheat field in babaji helmand province in the spring of 2011 evans was attached to the royal highland fusiliers 2 scots c company a heavy infantry patrol tasked with providing security in the

vicinity begun 2 years earlier the helmand food zone program was a form of development intervention which offered subsidies seed and fertilizers to farmers who replaced lucrative opium cultivation from poppies with growing and harvesting wheat and vegetable crops babaji had been in the control of insurgents until a few months earlier and had not received any assistance from the program during the previous year consequently there were tensions between the community and british forces as evans and the patrol emerged from the field an afghan man sitting nearby clearly irate shouted in pashto that the british soldiers had wanted the farmer to grow wheat instead of poppy and then the same british soldiers walked through their fields at the immediate level the encounter demonstrated the direct link between conflict food security and local trade but conflict has many interrelated and mutual dependencies such that the anecdote is instructive on myriad broader milieus where for example is the tipping point that makes a civilian value creating an expression of discontent to a heavily armed patrol above his immediate physical security do livelihoods and cultures affect military strategies are there interdependencies between insurgencies societies and economies does the language of war require a sociological grammar in order to be understood armed conflict is a human enterprise such that by extension understanding of the human dimension in a given area of operations should be thought integral to planning successful operations

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
