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approximately 1 million people commit suicide world wide annually and around 10 million attempt suicide each year suicide is a major public health problem throughout the world and major efforts are currently being made to help reduce these numbers however suicide is the result of complex interactions between a range of factors

including historical psychological cultural biological and social and any approach to treating the problem of suicide has to consider all these factors this new edition of the oxford textbook of suicidology and suicide prevention has been thoroughly updated and expanded since publication of the first edition in 2009 this comprehensive resource covers all aspects of suicidal behaviour and suicide prevention from a number of different perspectives including its underlying religious and cultural factors its political social and economic causes its psychiatric and somatic determinants and its public health impacts the new edition includes several new clinically focussed chapters devoted to major psychiatric disorders and their relation to suicide including mood and anxiety disorders substance abuse psychosis schizophrenia bipolar disorder eating disorders and personality disorders it also includes a fully updated section on psychometric scales used for measuring suicidal behaviour and instruments used in suicide preventative interventions part of the authoritative oxford textbooks in psychiatry series this second edition will continue to serve as the key reference source for both researchers and professionals working in the areas of suicidology and suicide prevention including psychiatrists clinical psychologists public health specialists and neuroscientists

this book is an exceptionally critical and insightful contribution to the scholarly discourse of suicidology the book offers in depth analyses of the conceptual evolution and various perspectives of suicide a very detailed mapping of the conceptualisation of the critical idiom of text explication of the theoretical contributions of barthes derrida foucault and others and analyses of suicides of immortalised characters forgotten writers and the culturally devoiced the book locates the notion of text in a range of literary and cultural theories from new criticism to new historicism and explores the methodology of analysing enigmatic suicides as texts in and of themselves

originally published in 1976 race and suicide in south africa synthesises the two dimensions of suicide the personal and the social phenomenon its approach is durkheimian in the use of court records and phenomenological in the examination of actual cases about 1500 cases of suicide in durban from 1940 70 are analysed in terms of race sex occupation marital status economic status family type and size residential area time and method used what emerges is a revealing picture of suicide

in south african ethnic groups the findings confute the idea of durkheim and others that behaviour in suicide conforms to certain universal principles and suggest the crucial role of particular social conditions in determining suicide trends while at the same time challenging the proposition that a high suicide rate is associated with high status instead the author found that there were common emotional syndromes among suicides but there were contributed to by different social factors

this work covers 840 intentional suicide cases initially reported in daily variety the entertainment industry s trade journal but also drawing attention from mainstream news media these cases are taken from the ranks of vaudeville film theatre dance music literature writers with direct connections to film and other allied fields in the entertainment industry from 1905 through 2000 accidentally self inflicted deaths are omitted except for a few controversial cases it includes the suicides of well known personalities such as actress peg entwistle who is the only person to ever commit suicide by jumping from the top of the hollywood sign marilyn monroe and dorothy dandridge who are believed to have overdosed on drugs and richard farnsworth and brian keith who shot themselves to end the misery of terminal cancer also mentioned but in less detail are the suicides of unknown and lesser known members of the entertainment industry arranged alphabetically each entry covers the person s personal and professional background method of suicide and in some instances includes actual statements taken from the suicide note

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
