the twenty first century reading war is in fact nothing new but some of the details are unique to our current culture driven by social media this volume seeks to examine the current reading war in the context of the historical recurrence of public and political debates around student reading abilities and achievement grounded in a media fascination with the science of reading and fueled by a rise in advocates for students with dyslexia the current reading war has resulted in some deeply troubling reading policy grade retention and intensive phonics programs this primer for parents policy makers and people who care confronts some of the most compelling but misunderstood aspects of teaching reading in the u s while also offering a way toward ending the reading war in order to serve all students regardless of their needs the revised expanded 2nd edition adds developments around the science of reading including the expanding impact on state policy and legislation as well as robust additions to the research base around teaching students to read

reading english verse in manuscript c 1350 c 1500 is the first book length history of reading for later middle english poetry while much past work in the history of reading has revolved around marginalia this book consults a wider range of evidence from the weights of books in medieval bindings to relationships between rhyme and syntax it combines literary critical close readings detailed case studies of particular surviving codices and systematic manuscript surveys drawing on continental european traditions of quantitative codicology to demonstrate the variety vitality and formal concerns visible in the reading of verse in this period the small and large scale formal features of poetry affected reading subtly but extensively determining how readers might move through books and even shaping physical books themselves readers responses to one formal feature rhyme meanwhile evince a habitual but therefore deep rooted formalism which can support and enhance close readings today reading english verse in manuscript sheds fresh light on poets such as geoffrey chaucer john lydgate and thomas hoccleve but also shows how their works were read in manuscript in the context of a much larger mass of anonymous poems that influenced canonical poems in a pattern of mutual influence

the teaching of english in the united arab emirates is based upon the communicative approach and aims to enable efl students to employ language skills for communication purposes as appropriate personal experience and the author s colleagues observations however reveal that a number of efl university students fail to achieve adequate communicative competence which in turn does not qualify them to exploit the foreign language of english as required by their curricula as well as by today s world central to university education in the united arab emirates is critical thinking it seems reasonable then to assume that efl university students are well equipped to tackle a reading text and to handle a writing task demonstrating through such activities an adequate repertoire of critical thinking skills personal experience and the author s colleagues observations however indicate that this does not apply to a number of efl university students studying in the country seeking an effective remedy the author argues that utilising literature in the efl classroom would be beneficial in terms of many essential aspects based on a three year research project conducted at a private university in dubai involving a number of efl students the book concludes with some suggestions with regards to what criteria to adopt when utilising literary texts the current book as such is expected to be of use and interest to applied linguists as the study proposes an approach to integrating the teaching of language literature communication and critical thinking with the ultimate goal of promoting communicative competence and enhancing critical thinking on the part of efl learners curricula designers since the study introduces a course for the enhancement of communicative competence and critical thinking and efl instructors because the study offers instructional material which can be adopted or adapted when teaching efl university students
