penelope wain believes that her lover neil macrae has been killed while serving overseas under her father that he died apparently in disgrace does not alter her love for him even though her father is insistent on his guilt what neither penelope or her father knows is that neil is not dead but has returned to halifax to clear his name hugh maclellan s first novel is a compelling romance set against the horrors of wartime and the catastrophic halifax explosion of december 6 1917

imagination and the creative impulse in the new literatures in english brings together the proceedings of a symposium organised by the editors at the university of trento in 1990 at a time when the study of the post colonial literatures is gaining more widespread recognition scholars based mainly at universities in italy and germany were invited to address the manner in which writers are giving literary expression to the complexity of contemporary post colonial and multicultural societies and to consider from their differing perspectives on the new literatures central questions of formal experimentation linguistic innovation social and political commitment textual theory and cross culturality focusing on such major writers such as achebe soyinka and walcott as well as on lesser known figures such as jack davis witi ihimaera rohinton mistry and manohar malgonkar the contributors take up many themes characteristic of the new literatures the challenge posed to traditional authority the expression of national identity the role of literature in the liberation struggle modes of literary practice in multicultural societies the relationship of the new literatures in english to that of the former metropolitan centre and the complex intertextuality characterizing much of the literary production of post colonial societies

december 6 2017 was the 100th anniversary of the halifax explosion as it unfolds against the compelling background of wartime halifax barometer rising exhibits all of what queen s professor d o spettigue describes as maclellan s imaginative power and literary craftsmanship the tight melodramatic plot fuses together a tender love story a bitter father son conflict and a desperate search centering on the famous harbour explosion the novel stands in the front ranks of canadian literature

canadian literary landmarks

w j keith has chosen to ignore utterly both the popular at the one extreme robert service lucy maud montgomery as well as the avant garde at the other bpnichol anne carson in favour of those authors whose style lends itself to the simple pleasure of reading and to that end keith dedicates his history to all those including those of the general reading public whose endangered status is much lamented who recognize and celebrate the dance of words

catching the torch examines contemporary novels and plays written about canada's participation in world war i exploring such works as jane urquhart's *the underpainter* and *the stone carvers* jack hodgins's *broken ground* kevin kerr's *unity* 1918 stephen massicotte's *mary's wedding* and frances itani's *deafening* the book considers how writers have dealt with the compelling myth that the canadian nation was born in the trenches of the great war in contrast to british and european remembrances of ww1 which tend to regard it as a cataclysmic destroyer of innocence or australian myths that promote an ideal of outsize masculinity physical bravery and white superiority contemporary canadian texts conjure up notions of distinctively canadian values tolerance of ethnic difference the ability to do one's duty without complaint or arrogance and the inclination to show moral as well as physical courage paradoxically canadians are shown to decry the horrors of war while making use of its productive cultural effects through a close analysis of the way sacrifice service and the commemoration of war are represented in these literary works *catching the torch* argues that iterations of a secure mythic notion of national identity one that is articulated via the representation of straightforward civic and military participation work to counter current anxieties about the stability of the nation state in particular anxieties about the failure of the ideal of a national character

critical interest in foreign novels especially the latin american and african novel has burgeoned in the past two decades the purpose of this reference bibliography is to provide easier access to the criticism produced from 1965 to 1975 on novels published in africa latin america europe asia canada australia and the middle east a second volume will cover criticism between 1976 and 1985 throughout this work the term foreign novel includes novels and other longer works of fiction produced in all countries other than the united states and the united kingdom coverage ranges in time of writing from apuleius' *metamorphosis* first century a.d. and murasaki's *tale of genji* 11th century to garcia marquez's *100 years of solitude* 1967 and margaret atwood's *surfacing* 1972 the 277 journals chosen primarily because of their wide circulation and 584 books indexed for relevant material contribute to the 13 000 bibliographic citations on 1 500 authors this is a reference tool which is surely essential for any library or world literature scholar

included in this collection of critical essays are new essays on leonard cohen and brian moore all the other articles have appeared in various canadian literary journals there are critical looks at the works of hugh maclellan morley callaghan wyndham lewis malcolm lowry irving layton a.j.m. smith and earle birney woodcock offers comment on edmund wilson's views on canadian literature and provides a valuable analysis of the level of criticism and the state of prominent literary publications in canada william new's perceptive introduction brings new insights to bear on one of canada's best respected literary critics

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
