and it swept across the continent of europe like wildfire being adopted by one ruler after another it even crossed the atlantic to the new united states of america into the hands of president thomas jefferson in a wonderful sentence which concludes beccaria s book he sums up matters as follows in order that every punishment may not be an act of violence committed by one man or by many against a single individual it ought to be above all things public speedy necessary the least possible in the given circumstances proportioned to its crime and dictated by the laws civilising penal law remains a topical issue but it began with cesare beccaria
