jane austen 16 december 1775 – 18 july 1817 was an english novelist whose works of romantic fiction set among the gentry earned her a place as one of the most widely read writers in english literature her realism and biting social commentary cementing her historical importance among scholars and critics austen lived her entire life as part of a close knit family located on the lower fringes of the english gentry she was educated primarily by her father and older brothers as well as through her own reading the steadfast support of her family was critical to her development as a professional writer her artistic apprenticeship lasted from her teenage years until she was about 35 years old during this period she experimented with various literary forms including the epistolary novel which she tried then abandoned and wrote and extensively revised three major novels and began a fourth from 1811 until 1816 with the release of *sense and sensibility* 1811 *pride and prejudice* 1813 *mansfield park* 1814 and *emma* 1816 she achieved success as a published writer she wrote two additional novels *northanger abbey* and *persuasion* both published posthumously in 1818 and began a third which was eventually titled *sanditon* but died before completing it jane austen had contracted addison s disease a tubercular disease of the kidneys no longer able to walk far she used to drive out in a little donkey carriage which can still be seen at the jane austen museum at chawton by may 1817 she was so ill that she and her older sister cassandra from whom she was always inseparable rented rooms in winchester to be near jane s physician tragically there was then no cure and jane austen died in her sister s arms in the early hours of 18 july 1817 she was 41 years old she is buried in winchester cathedral
