Congress also created organized crime as we know it. Italian, Jewish, and Irish mobs sprang up to supply the suddenly illegal commodity to the millions of people still eager to drink it. Men like Lucky Luciano and Meyer Lansky, Dutch Schultz and Bugsy Siegel, Al Capone in Chicago and Nucky Johnson in Atlantic City waged a brutal war for power in the streets and on the waterfronts. But if you think you already know this story, think again. Since you've never seen it through the eyes of one of the mobsters who lived it, called one of the most significant organized crime figures in the United States by the U.S. District Attorney Vincent Jimmy Blue Eyes, Al was just 15 years old when Prohibition became law. Over the next decade, Al would work side by side with Lansky and Luciano as they navigated the brutal underworld of bootlegging, thievery, and murder. Al's later career included prison time and the ultimate mob tribute: being immortalized as Johnny Ola in *The Godfather Part II*. Introduced to the 91-year-old Al living in retirement in Florida, Dylan Struzan based this book on more than 50 hours of recorded testimony. Stories Al had never shared and that he forbade her to publish until after he was gone, Al died peacefully two months short of his 97th birthday. And now his stories, bracing and violent, full of intrigue and betrayal, hunger and hubris, can finally be told. Dylan Struzan has delivered a soaring treat for those of us who love mobster history: a sprawling saga drawn not from rumor or recycled myth but directly from the horse's mouth. The second largest economy in Latin America, Mexico seems poised to enter a new growth phase as the government of Enrique Peña Nieto implements radical changes in a number of sectors across the economy. The reforms aimed at raising the competitiveness of the Mexican economy have the potential to establish Mexico's position as a regional powerhouse. Optimism surrounding the recent wave of reforms coupled with a stable macroeconomic environment and an improved credit rating from international agencies has placed Mexico centre stage. Despite slower than anticipated growth of 1.1% in 2013, a wave of reforms affecting a range of sectors is expected to bring a new dynamism to the economy and continue to attract increasing amounts of foreign investment. A highly anticipated energy reform approved by Congress in 2013 will for the first time in decades open the nationalised oil industry to foreign investment while a new public-private partnership law is set to provide the climate of legal certainty needed to attract private investment in the myriad of sectors undergoing expansion. While challenges remain in particular informality and deficient domestic supply chains, growth prospects remain positive for the second largest economy in Latin America.

the economy has a history of strong government involvement and a legacy of socialist policies in the 1960s and 1970s with statist companies involved in both energy and agriculture yet the country's market is now among the more liberalised in the region. Ghana has a strong export profile although it is somewhat dependent on commodities; it is the world's second largest exporter of cocoa behind Côte d'Ivoire and one of the continent's largest gold producers while new reserves of oil and gas have helped further expand its resource wealth. The economy saw expansion of 7.1 in 2013 while inflation reached 14.5 in March 2014. Although inflation and balance of payments remain the country's biggest economic challenges, measures have been taken to strengthen the cedi and curb inflation.

Economic growth has been extremely robust following the country's discovery of oil in 2007, reaching well into the double digits and driving a boom in consumption and investment. The discovery in Ghana's offshore Jubilee field in 2007 represented something of a turning point in the country's economic trajectory, followed by growth rates that at one point reached above 14, as well as a GDP re-basing that improved the accuracy of its reporting. The country has moved up into lower middle income status as a result of its recent economic surge and stable environment. Investment levels have continued to rise as companies, both foreign and domestic, are eager to capitalise on the country's wealth of natural resources and growing middle class. There have been challenges as public spending comes under pressure and commodity exports remain exposed to exogenous shocks, but the economy's fundamentals are encouraging.

Tunisia's GDP totalled \$84.3bn / \$6.2bn in 2015, expanding at a rate of 0.8, down from growth of 2.3 the year before. The fall was due to a variety of external factors, including two terrorist incidents that negatively affected the tourism sector in particular and shook business confidence more generally. However, growth picked up somewhat in 2016, standing at 1.1, 4 and 1.3 in the first, second and third quarters of the year respectively, and is expected to maintain this upward trend in 2017, supported by greater export competitiveness. Moves to bolster the economy through reforms such as the new investment law and plans to tackle wider structural issues are likely to help to raise growth to higher levels than those witnessed in recent years, as should the improvement in security since the 2015 attacks, though the extent of this will depend in part on whether or not the economy of the country's main export destination and tourism source market, the Eurozone, can emerge from its own recent slowdown.
