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in this thriller with literary merit time out new york a stunning narrative combines the gritty rhythms of junot diaz with the noir genius of walter mosley bodega dreams pulls us into spanish harlem where the word is out willie bodega is king need college tuition for your daughter start up funds for your fruit stand bodega can help he gives everyone a leg up in exchange only for

loyalty and a steady income from the drugs he pushes lyrical inspired and darkly funny this powerful debut novel brilliantly evokes the trial of chino a smart promising young man to whom bodega turns for a favor chino is drawn to bodega s street smart idealism but soon finds himself over his head navigating an underworld of switchblade tempers turncoat morality and murder bodega is a fascinating character the story quiñonez tells has energy and verve the new york times book review

dávila s keen insights into the politics of marketing ethnicity community marginalization and class divisions cuts through neo liberal postures to glaringly reveal the real issue who will construct and control east harlem s future well versed in the scholarship dávila has produced a book that is essential for understanding the increasingly important role and aspirations of puerto rican and latino communities in new york s history virginia sánchez korrol author of from colonia to community the history of puerto ricans in new york city providing an expansive ethnographic portal into new york s famous el barrio davila documents the ways in which the neighborhood s latino cultures can be commodified as a magnet for gentrification as well as providing an obstacle to it an absorbing read providing a unique contemporary perspective on east harlem neil smith author of american empire roosevelt s geographer and the prelude to globalization unlike most ethnographers of the urban poor in search of authentic street experience dávila gives us an ethnography of power with rich insights and sensitivity she documents the pitched battles between developers politicians long time residents newcomers puerto ricans mexicans and african americans over space gentrification and cultural representation in east harlem dávila peels back the many layers of local stories in order to reveal a complex national story of resistance against urban neoliberalism robin d g kelley author of freedom dreams the black radical imagination

the latinx urban condition brings together interdisciplinary cultural theory and u s latinx urban literature into conversation focusing on the realities and urban experiences of latinx living in major cities in the united states from the 1960s to the present the manuscript focuses on analyzing the works of latinx authors who write about the city in which they were raised and how growing up in these environments shaped their lives their communities and their future their fictional work helps us understand how the human and cultural tapestry of the latinx community is inextricably connected to the spatial

transformations taking place in many cities across the country most notably within the cities the authors write about in their narratives this is particularly true when the city is represented through a fictional narrative which is full of detailed information about the realities of structural inequality in education residential segregation urban cultural identity discrimination experiences of exile oppression urban desires integration and disillusionment the main purpose is to analyze the symbolic realities lived by the characters in order to understand how latino families and communities are experiencing displacement under instituted neoliberal policies a process known as development and progress or gentrification

defending their own in the cold the cultural turns of u s puerto ricans explores u s puerto rican culture in past and recent contexts the book presents east coast midwest and chicago cultural production while exploring puerto rican musical film artistic and literary performance working within the theoretical frame of cultural postcolonial and diasporic studies marc zimmerman relates the experience of puerto ricans to that of chicanos and cuban americans showing how even supposedly mainstream u s puerto ricans participate in a performative culture that embodies elements of possible cultural ricanstruction defending their own in the cold examines various dimensions of u s puerto rican artistic life including relations with other ethnic groups and resistance to colonialism and cultural assimilation to illustrate how puerto ricans have survived and created new identities and relations out of their colonized and diasporic circumstances zimmerman looks at the cultural examples of latino entertainment stars such as jennifer lopez and benicio del toro visual artists juan sánchez ramón flores and elizam escobar as well as nuyorican dancer turned midwest poet carmen pursifull the book includes a comprehensive chapter on the development of u s puerto rican literature and a pioneering essay on chicago puerto rican writing a final essay considers cuban cultural attitudes towards puerto ricans in a testimonial narrative by miguel barnet and reaches conclusions about the past and future of u s puerto rican culture zimmerman offers his own semi outsider point of reference as a jewish american latin americanist who grew up near new york city matured in california went on to work with and teach latinos in the midwest and eventually married a woman from a puerto rican family with island and u s roots

ginwright examines the role of community based organizations cbos in the lives and development of black urban youth the author argues that these organizations have the potential to provide a powerful influence in how young people choose to participate in schooling and civic life ginwright bases his observations on a five year study of a cbo he created in oakland california the book shows readers that the lives of poor black urban youth are not quite as determined by locale and income as more deterministic readings have argued and that there is real hope for positive change in these urban communities

the need for continued research at the middle level is clear and urgent the previous volumes in this handbook series testify to this urgency while quantitative studies continue to be essential there is a critical need to understand the complexities of the middle level community one way to capture the rich diverse mosaic of the voices and experiences of middle level participants and stakeholders is to use narrative inquiry methodology the intent of this volume in the handbook is to give voice to and broaden our understanding of the wide variety of participants and stakeholders who weave through the middle level such participants and stakeholders may include middle level teachers school psychologists and counselors students parents administrators middle level researchers research foundations and community groups in addition to hearing directly from these groups this volume will focus on the intricate webs connections and questions that these narratives hold and frame them within current middle level research theory and practice ultimately this volume will highlight the nuance diversity and future directions that research may need to explore

the sixteen essays in writing off the hyphen approach the literature of the puerto rican diaspora from current theoretical positions with provocative and insightful results prominent writers such as rosario ferr and judith ortiz cofer are discussed alongside often neglected writers such as honolulu based rodney morales and gay writer manuel ramos otero jos torres padilla

what can there possibly be left to say about this common litany resonant both in and outside of academia reflects a growing sense that the number of subjects and authors appropriate for literary study is rapidly becoming exhausted take heart admonishes richard kopley in this dynamic new anthology for this is decidedly not the case while generations of literary study have unquestionably covered much ground in analyzing canonical writers many aspects of even the most well known authors both their lives and their work remain underexamined among the authors discussed are t s eliot ralph waldo emerson william faulkner harriet beecher stowe walt whitman ernest hemingway richard wright edith wharton nathaniel hawthorne zora neale hurston henry james willa cather herman melville edgar allan poe henry david thoreau and mark twain

based on the premise that literature liberates thinking and argument disciplines it this anthology features a critical thinking analytical approach that readers in turn will apply to their own thought and writing processes it introduces and explains the tools of argument and presents reading selections centered on four enduring themes individuality and community nature and place family and identity and power and responsibility for those interested in literature composition and argumentative writing

provides a comprehensive alphabetically arranged overview of literary works including plays poetry short stories novels and nonfiction from lonesome dove to white house correspondents association dinner 2006 speech

this study combines approaches of the humanities and social sciences to explore contemporary caribbean narratives of the historical trauma of slavery and the revolutionary or subversive strategies of anti colonial struggle drawing on various works novels films plays political pamphlets by writers and activists such as frantz fanon antonio benítez rojo michelle cliff erna brodber wilson harris iris morales nicholasa mohl culture clash and the young lords the project traces narratives of historical slave uprisings maroon wars and struggles against colonial and neo colonial governments in and around the caribbean contradictory violence addresses questions of the legitimacy of violence in the struggle for liberation the price to be paid by

individuals and groups for the decision to begin such a forceful struggle the possibility of escaping the colonizers value system through reverse discourse and the limits and possibilities of writing violence in a reversal of older master narratives of the postcolonial nation contemporary caribbean works have produced new definitions of nationhood which nevertheless keep the nation intact as a site of agency and create an alternative vision of the americas which could serve to remap the geo political boundaries existing on the american continent today
