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the nazi holocaust is one of the most momentous events in human history yet it remains on many levels a baffling and unfathomable mystery by shunning simplistic explanations ronnie landau has set out in a clear thought provoking and enlightened fashion to mediate between this vast often unapproachable subject and the reader who wrestles with its meaning locating the holocaust within a number of different contexts jewish history german history genocide in the modern age the larger story of human bigotry and the triumph of ideology over conscience landau penetrates to the very heart of its moral and historical significance deeply concerned lest the holocaust as a unique phenomenon be cordoned off from the rest of human history and ghettoized within the highly charged realm of jewish experience he is at pains to show that transmitting understanding of the holocaust is about connecting with all humanity intended both for the general reader and for students and academics especially in history psychology literature and the humanities this work is an important breakthrough in the struggle to perpetuate the memory of a tragedy which the world is all too ready to forget

catholic and protestant bishops during the period of the third reich are often accused of being either sympathetic to the nazi regime or at least generally tolerant of its anti jewish stance so long as the latter did not infringe on the functions of the church with some notable exceptions that accusation is extended to many lesser figures including seminary professors and pastors most notably the exceptions include such martyred heroes as dietrich bonhoeffer and max metzger religious activists and writers still of great influence among catholic theologians the record is no less cloudy theology and politics while discussing a range of religious scholars focuses on five major theologians who were born during the kulturkampf came to maturity and international recognition during the hitler era and had an influence on catholicism in the english speaking world three were in varying degrees and for varying lengths of time sympathetic to the professed goals of the third reich karl adam karl eschweiler and joseph lortz the other two romano guardini and engelbert krebs were publicly critical of the new regime interestingly the two theologians who have had the greatest influence in the english speaking world guardini and adam were initially on opposite sides of the nazi divide the interplay of theology and politics to which the title refers is evident in the fact that while all the theologians differed from the classic theology of the church as a perfect society and were progressive in their rejection of neo scholastic

methodology they differed among themselves in envisaging the church either as the enemy of modernity or as its religious dialogue partner the first group initially approving the reich agenda were adam eschweiler the most ardent supporter and lortz the second included guardini and krebs the most ardent opponent

h h laughlin was crucial for the nazi s crusade to breed a master race this american positioned himself to have a significant effect on the world s population during his career laughlin wrote the model eugenical law copied by the nazis to draft the nuremberg racial decrees was appointed as an expert witness for the u s congress when the 1924 immigration restriction act was passed the 1924 act would prevent jewish refugees from reaching the safety of u s shores during the holocaust provided the scientific basis for the 1927 supreme court case of buck v bell that made eugenic sterilization legal in the united states over 80 000 americans were sterilized against their will as a consequence defended hitler s nuremberg decrees as scientifically sound in the american press in order to dispel the criticism of nazi eugenics created the political organization that ensured that scientific racialism would survive the negative taint of the holocaust and be instrumental in the jim crow era of american legislative racism h h laughlin was given an honorary degree from heidelberg university by hitler s government specifically for these accomplishments yet no one has ever written a book on laughlin despite the vast number of books about the holocaust laughlin is mostly unknown outside of academic circles h h laughlin was funded by the carnegie institution of washington d c this author was given permission to survey the institution s laughlin s archived correspondence these documents had not been seen for decades and were all but lost to history they are the backbone of this book as they evidence laughlin s collaboration with hitler s henchmen the story told by these long forgotten documents intensifies at the juncture when the carnegie leadership came to the horrible realization that one of its most recognized scientists was supporting hitler s regime h h laughlin com note this book was circulated amongst academic circles and other interested parties as an advanced readers copy a r c in 2015 it is a part the eugenics anthology seven book series that is currently being completed by a e samaan hardbound versions of the books will not be released until the series is complete and all the puzzle pieces in place for more information please visit eugenicsanthology.com

this book is intended as a characterological history of the germans german history viewed as the formation of the german character it suggests some reasons why the term capitalism can be properly applied only to commercial development in germany

mergefield ai copy in 1933 jews and to a lesser extent political opponents of the nazis suffered an unprecedented loss of positions and livelihood at germany s universities with few exceptions the academic elite welcomed and justified the acts of the nazi regime uttered no word of protest when their jewish and liberal colleagues were dismissed and did not stir when jewish students were barred admission the subject of how german scholars responded to the nazi regime continues to be a fascinating area of scholarship in this collection rabinbach and bialas bring some of the best scholarly contributions together in one cohesive volume to deliver a shocking conclusion whatever diverse motives german intellectuals may have had in 1933 the image of nazism as an alien power imposed on german universities from without was a convenient fiction
