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William Lowndes Yancey 1814–63 was one of the leading secessionists of the old south in this first comprehensive biography Eric H. Walther examines the personality and political life of the uncompromising fire eater born in Georgia but raised in the north by a fiercely abolitionist stepfather and an emotionally unstable mother Yancey grew up

believing that abolitionists were cruel meddling and hypocritical his personal journey led him through a series of mentors who transformed his political views and upon moving to frontier alabama in his twenties yancey s penchant for rhetorical and physical violence was soon channeled into a crusade to protect slaveholders rights yancey defied northern democrats at their national nominating convention in 1860 rending the party and setting the stage for secession after the election of abraham lincoln selected to introduce jefferson davis in montgomery as the president elect of the confederacy yancey also served the confederacy as a diplomat and a senator before his death in 1863 just short of his forty ninth birthday more than a portrait of an influential political figure before and during the civil war this study also presents a nuanced look at the roots of southern honor violence and understandings of manhood as they developed in the nineteenth century

a controversial character largely known as depicted in the movie glory as a union colonel who led black soldiers in the civil war james montgomery 1814 71 waged a far more personal and radical war against slavery than popular history suggests it is the true story of this militant abolitionist that todd mildfelt and david d schaffer tell in abolitionist of the most dangerous kind summoning a life fiercely lived in struggle against the expansion of slavery into the west and during the civil war this book follows a harrowing path through the turbulent world of the 1850s and 1860s as montgomery with the fervor of an old testament prophet inflicts destructive retribution on southern slaveholders wherever he finds them crossing paths with notable abolitionists john brown and harriet tubman along the way during the tumultuous years of bleeding kansas he became a guerilla chieftain of the antislavery vigilantes known as jayhawkers when the war broke out in 1861 montgomery led a regiment of white troops who helped hundreds of enslaved people in missouri reach freedom in kansas drawing on regimental records in the national archives the authors provide new insights into the experiences of african american men who served in montgomery s next regiment the thirty fourth united states colored troops formerly second south carolina infantry montgomery helped enslaved men and women escape via one of the least explored underground railways in the nation from arkansas and missouri through kansas and nebraska with support of abolitionists in massachusetts he spearheaded resistance to the fugitive slave act in kansas and when war came he led black soldiers in striking at the very heart of the confederacy his full story thus illuminates the actions of both militant abolitionists and the enslaved people fighting to destroy the peculiar institution

a comprehensive study of secession in all fifteen slave states rebels in the making is a political social and economic history of the late antebellum south that examines the appeal of secession to a variety of actors in these states and reveals it to be not a mass democratic movement but a revolution led from above

the first armed conflict in kentucky with the first casualties on both side the north and the south where the first confederate officer was killed and other tidbits of local

history

this is a case study of possibly the most complex defensive system in australia between 1803 and 1945 defending victoria was such a wide ranging and demanding task that the colony and later the state of victoria was known as the gibraltar of the south this book fills a major gap in australian military and naval history using victoria as a case study the book shows how defence developed from the idea of a basic sand fort emanating from a fear of french invasion during the early 19th century into a complex modern three dimensional defensive system incorporating air land and sea defences as well as radar and secret defence technology by the 1940s the book is not a simple narration of facts and events but a substantial addition to australian military history on account of its extensive analysis of the political social economic and technological factors which impacted defence over many decades of the 19th century

most americans imagine the civil war in terms of clear and defined boundaries of freedom and slavery a straightforward division between the slave states of kentucky and missouri and the free states of illinois indiana ohio and kansas however residents of these western border states abraham lincoln s home region had far more ambiguous identities and contested political loyalties than we commonly assume in the rivers ran backward christopher phillips sheds light on the fluid political cultures of the middle border states during the civil war era far from forming a fixed and static boundary between the north and south the border states experienced fierce internal conflicts over their political and social loyalties white supremacy and widespread support for the existence of slavery pervaded the free states of ohio indiana and illinois which had much closer economic and cultural ties to the south while those in kentucky and missouri held little identification with the south except over slavery debates raged at every level from the individual to the state in parlors churches schools and public meeting places among families neighbors and friends ultimately the pervasive violence of the civil war and the cultural politics that raged in its aftermath proved to be the strongest determining factor in shaping these states regional identities leaving an indelible imprint on the way in which americans think of themselves and others in the nation the rivers ran backward reveals the complex history of the western border states as they struggled with questions of nationalism racial politics secession neutrality loyalty and even place as the civil war tore the nation and themselves apart in this major work phillips shows that the civil war was more than a conflict pitting the north against the south but one within the west that permanently reshaped american regions

responding to president lincoln s initial call for troops the 18th new york infantry emerged as one of the excelsior state s first regiments and mustered many of its earliest volunteers formed of companies from across the state the unit saw combat early suffering the first casualties of the bull run campaign when they were ambushed on the

march four days before the battle as part of the army of the potomac they fought at gaines s mill crampton s gap antietam fredericksburg and chancellorsville drawing on numerous sources including several unpublished letters and diaries this book gives the complete history of the 18th from the first enlistee to the last surviving veteran who died in 1938 with an emphasis on the experiences of individual soldiers

the third texas cavalry regiment recruited from twenty six counties of northeastern texas was one of the most famous confederate units from the lone star state douglas hale narrates troop movements and battle actions sensitively portraying the sufferings and private thoughts of individual cavalrymen and their commanders as they marched back and forth across the southern landscape

thoroughly researched hubbard s interpretation is solid well supported and touches all of the major aspects of confederate diplomacy american historical review as the first examination of the topic since king cotton diplomacy 1931 this work deserves widespread attention hubbard offers a convincingly bleak portrayal of the limited skills and myopic vision of rebel diplomacy at home and abroad virginia magazine of history and biography of the many factors that contributed to the south s loss of the civil war one of the most decisive was the failure of southern diplomacy in this penetrating work charles m hubbard reassesses the diplomatic efforts made by the confederacy in its struggle to become an independent nation hubbard focuses both on the confederacy s attempts to negotiate a peaceful separation from the union and southern diplomats increasingly desperate pursuit of state recognition from the major european powers drawing on a large body of sources hubbard offers an important reinterpretation of the problems facing confederate diplomats he demonstrates how the strategies and objectives of the south s diplomatic program themselves often poorly conceived were then placed in the hands of inexperienced envoys who were ill equipped to succeed in their roles as negotiators the author charles m hubbard is associate professor of history at lincoln memorial university and executive director of the abraham lincoln memorial museum in harrogate tennessee

before the civil war george proctor kane had been a businessman thespian political appointee philanthropist and militiaman during the war as baltimore s chief of police he harbored the divided loyalties familiar to the border states southern in his sentiments yet northern in his allegiances as the city s top lawman he sought to reform baltimore s mobtown image he ensured that president elect lincoln passing through on the way to his inauguration was not assassinated he protected union troops marching to defend washington d c he was eventually imprisoned as a southern sympathizer denied habeas corpus as his captors transferred him from prison to prison this book recounts kane s enigmatic public life before and during the civil war his confederate activities after prison and his return to serve as mayor of baltimore

science is a living organic activity the meaning and understanding of which have evolved incrementally over human history this book the second in a roughly chronological series explores the evolution of science from the advents of christianity and islam through the middle ages focusing especially on the historical relationship between science and religion specific topics include technological innovations during the middle ages islamic science the crusades gothic cathedrals and the founding of western universities close attention is given to such figures as paul the apostle hippolytus lactantius cyril of alexandria hypatia cosmas indicopleustes and the prophet mohammed

an important book that rescues george b mcclellan s military reputation chronicles bold brash and full of ambition george brinton mcclellan seemed destined for greatness when he assumed command of all the union armies before he was 35 it was not to be ultimately deemed a failure on the battlefield by abraham lincoln he was finally dismissed from command following the bloody battle of antietam to better understand this fascinating however flawed character ethan s rafuse considers the broad and complicated political climate of the earlier 19th century rather than blaming mcclellan for the union s military losses rafuse attempts to understand his political thinking as it affected his wartime strategy as a result rafuse sheds light not only on mcclellan s conduct on the battlefields of 1861 62 but also on united states politics and culture in the years leading up to the civil war any historian seriously interested in the period will come away from the book with useful material and a better understanding of george b mcclellan journal of southern history exhaustively researched and lucidly written rafuse has done an excellent job in giving us a different perspective on little mac civil war history rafuse s thoughtful study of little mac shows just how enthralling this complex and flawed individual continues to be blue gray magazine

when confederate major general j e b stuart said north carolina has done nobly in this army he had one of his own men to thank brigadier general james byron gordon a protege of stuart gordon was the consummate nineteenth century landowner politician and businessman despite a lack of military training he rose rapidly through the ranks and as the commander of all north carolina cavalymen in the army of northern virginia he helped bring unparalleled success to stuart s famed confederate cavalry this updated biography originally published in 1996 chronicles gordon s early life and military career and through his men takes a fresh look at the vaunted army of northern virginia its battles controversies and troops this second edition includes additional source material that has come to light and a roster of gordon s 1st north carolina cavalry

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
