this study entails a theoretical reading of the Iranian modern history and follows an interdisciplinary agenda at the intersection of philosophy psychoanalysis economics and politics and intends to offer a novel framework for the analysis of socio economic development in Iran in the modern era a brief review of Iranian modern history from the constitutional revolution to the oil nationalization movement the 1979 Islamic revolution and the recent reformist and green movements demonstrates that Iranian people travelled full circle this historical experience of socio economic development revolving around the bitter question of why are we backward and its manifestation in perpetual socio political instability and violence is the subject matter of this study Michel Foucault's conceived relation between the production of truth and production of wealth captures the essence of hypothesis offered in this study Foucault 1980 93 94 maintains that in the last analysis we must produce truth as we must produce wealth indeed we must produce truth in order to produce wealth in the first place based on a hybrid methodology combining hermeneutics of understanding and hermeneutics of suspicion this monograph proposes that the failure to produce wealth has had particular roots in the failure in the production of truth and trust at the heart of the proposed theoretical model is the following formula the Iranian subject's confused preference structure culminates in the

formation of unstable coalitions which in turn leads to institutional failure creating a chaotic social order and a turbulent history as experienced by the iranian nation in the modern era as such the society oscillates between the chaotic states of socio political anarchy emanating from irreconcilable differences between and within social assemblages and their affiliated hybrid forms of regimes of truth in the springs of freedom and repressive states of order in the winters of discontent each time after the experience of chaos the order is restored based on the emergence of a final arbiter iranian leviathan as the evolved coping strategy for achieving conflict resolution this highly volatile truth cycle produces the experience of socio economic backwardness and violence the explanatory power of the theoretical framework offered in the study exploring the relation between the production of truth trust and wealth is demonstrated via providing historical examples from strong events of iranian modern history the significant policy implications of the model are explored this monograph will appeal to researchers scholars graduate students policy makers and anyone interested in the middle eastern politics iran development studies and political economy

unprecedented human and environmental catastrophe safronov explores the core themes of nietzsche s political economy debt slavery and the division of labour with reference to the influential views of adam smith and karl marx as well as against the backdrop of the long depression 1873 1896 the first truly international crisis of industrial capitalism during which most of nietzsche s work was completed in nietzsche s assessment modern political economy is predicated on the valuations that diminish humankind s prospects and harm the planet s future by consistently enfeebling the present as long as there is profit to be made from it nietzsche s critical insight which challenges the most fundamental tenet of modern economics and finance is that in order to build a stronger and intrinsically more valuable future in lieu of simply speculating on it as though the liberal promised land could descend upon us like the manna from heaven at the wave of an invisible hand of the market it is necessary to walk from the future we dare to envisage resolutely back to the present we inhabit to determine what demands achieving such a vision would impose upon us instead of embellishing the here and now by cynically discounting the future to the net value of the present while disparaging disowning and rewriting the past to unburden ourselves of its troubling legacy as we continue to frivolously squander its capital to the alluring tunes of the sirens who in the marketplace sing to us of the future the enabling mechanism for changing our valuing perspectives nietzsche tells us lies dormant in us and it must be unlocked before it is too late

in this elegantly written and beautifully illustrated book nico israel reveals how spirals are at the heart of the most significant literature and visual art of the twentieth century juxtaposing the work of writers and artists including w b yeats and vladimir tatlin james joyce and marcel duchamp and samuel beckett and robert smithson he argues that spirals provide a crucial frame for understanding the mutual involvement of modernity history and geopolitics complicating the spatio temporal logic

of literary and artistic genres and of scholarly disciplines the book takes the spiral not only as its topic but as its method drawing on the writings of walter benjamin and alain badiou israel theorizes a way of reading spirals responding to their dual directionality as well as their affective power the sensations associated with spirals flying falling drowning being smothered reflect the anxieties of limits tested or breached and israel charts these limits as they widen from the local to the global and recoil back chapters mix literary and art history to explore pataphysics futurism vorticism dada and surrealism concentricism minimalism and entropic earth art a coda considers the work of novelist w g sebald and contemporary artist william kentridge in spirals israel offers a refreshingly original approach to the history of modernism and its aftermaths one that gives modernist studies comparative literature and art criticism an important new spin

this book is unique in its utilization of the natural sciences to explain and illustrate key concepts of communist philosophy in its recapitulation of the spirit of engels s unfinished manuscript the dialectics of nature it relies on the physical sciences developed since engels s time to reaffirm the validity of materialist dialectics a point which is more easily made in the context of natural phenomena than it is in social phenomena the basic philosophical tenets underlying communist ideology are all supported by the natural sciences the book is situated within the marxist leninist maoist tradition its overarching theme is the need to reclaim our most fundamental weapon of that tradition it s methodology or philosophy which has been vitiated or even scrapped by well intentioned revolutionaries throughout the 20th century in particular some of mao s philosophical formulations are found to be erroneous and in opposition to his practice with the rapidly accelerating deterioration of the global capitalist order in progress since 2007 the urgency of this reclamation cannot be over emphasized

this book disentangles two terms that were conflated in the initial anglo american appropriation of french theory deconstruction and poststructuralism focusing on sartre derrida foucault and baudrillard but also considering levinas blanchot de man and others it traces the turn from a deconstruction inflected by phenomenology to a poststructuralism formed by the rejection of models based on consciousness in favor of ones based on language and structure the book provides a wide ranging and complex genealogy of french theory from the 1940s onward placing particular emphasis on the largely neglected early work of the theorists involved and on deconstruction s continuing relevance the author argues that deconstruction is a form of radical antiscientific modernity an interdisciplinary reconfiguration of philosophy as it confronted the positivism of the

human sciences in the 1960s by contrast poststructuralism is a type of postmodern theory inflected by changes in technology and the mode of information inasmuch as poststructuralism is founded upon its constitutive loss of phenomenology in Judith Butler's phrase the author is also concerned with the ways phenomenology particularly Sartre's forgotten but seminal being and nothingness is remembered repeated in different ways and never quite worked through in its theoretical successors thus the book also exemplifies a way of reading intellectual history that is not only concerned with the transmission of concepts but also with the processes of transference mourning and disavowal that inform the relationships between bodies of thought

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
