Visual Imagine a sundrenched California beach The waves gently lap the shore creating a rhythmic pulse This is the kind of feeling you want to evoke with your flute playing

How to Approach the California Dreaming Flute Solo A StepbyStep Guide

- 1 Choose your Version There are numerous arrangements of California Dreaming available for flute ranging from simple melodies to more complex versions with added embellishments Select an arrangement that suits your skill level and desired complexity Sites like SheetMusicPlus or Musicnotescom are excellent resources
- 2 Analyze the Melody Carefully study the melody and identify key phrases and emotional shifts Mark these on your sheet music to help you guide your interpretation
- 2 3 Develop your Phrasing Phrasing is crucial for conveying the songs emotion Experiment with different breath markings and articulation to create a natural flowing sound Listen to recordings of the original song and other flute renditions to get inspiration
- 4 Incorporate Dynamics Dont play the entire solo at the same volume Use dynamics changes in volume to create interest and highlight key moments Think about using pianissimo very soft passages to create a sense of intimacy and crescendo gradually increasing volume to build intensity
- 5 Explore Ornamentation Depending on your arrangement and skill level you can add tasteful ornamentation to enhance the melody Trills grace notes and appoggiaturas can add subtle color and texture but use them sparingly to avoid overwhelming the melodys natural beauty
- 6 Practice with a Metronome While rubato is important maintaining a solid

what if anything do dreams tell us about ourselves what is the relationship between types of sleep and types of dreams does dreaming serve any purpose or are dreams simply meaningless mental noise unmusical fingers wandering over the piano keys with expertise in philosophy psychology and neuroscience owen flanagan is uniquely qualified to answer these questions and in dreaming souls he provides both an accessible survey of the latest research on sleep and dreams and a compelling new theory about the nature and function of dreaming flanagan argues that while sleep has a clear biological function and adaptive value dreams are merely side effects free riders irrelevant from an evolutionary point of view but dreams are hardly unimportant indeed flanagan argues that dreams are self expressive the result of our need to find or to create meaning even when we re sleeping rejecting freud s theory of manifest and latent content of repressed wishes appearing in disguised form flanagan shows how brainstem activity during sleep generates a jumbled profusion of memories images thoughts emotions and desires which the cerebral cortex then attempts to shape into a more or less coherent story such dream narratives range from the relatively mundane worries of non rem sleep to the fantastic confabulations of deep rem that resemble psychotic episodes in their strangeness but however bizarre these narratives may be they can shed light on our mental life our well being and our sense of self written with clarity lively wit and remarkable insight dreaming souls offers a fascinating new way of apprehending one of the oldest mysteries of mental life

shortlisted for the penderyn music book prize 2017 in this first installment of acclaimed music writer david toop s interdisciplinary and sweeping overview of free improvisation into the maelstrom music improvisation and the dream of freedom before 1970 introduces the philosophy and practice of improvisation both musical and otherwise within the historical context of the post world war ii era neither strictly chronological or exclusively a history into the maelstrom investigates a wide range of improvisational tendencies from surrealist automatism to stream of consciousness in literature and vocalization from the free music of percy grainger to the free improvising groups emerging out of the early 1960s group ongaku nuova consonanza mev amm the spontaneous music ensemble and from free jazz to the strands of free improvisation that sought to distance itself from jazz in exploring the diverse ways in which spontaneity became a core value in the early

twentieth century as well as free improvisation's connection to both 1960s rock the beatles cream pink floyd and the era of post cagean indeterminacy in composition toop provides a definitive and all encompassing exploration of free improvisation up to 1970 ending with the late 1960s international developments of free music from roscoe mitchell in chicago peter brötzmann in berlin and han bennink and misha mengelberg in amsterdam
